BFDC earns Tk 32 lakh as net profit

The Bangladesh Fisheries Development Corporation (BFDC) earned Taka 32 lakh as net profit this year after continuous loss over last eight years, reports BSS.

This was informed at the concluding session of the three-day review meeting on the progress of 17 projects of the organisation here yesterday with Fisheries and Livestock Minister Abdullah Al-Noman in the chair.

The acting chairman of the organisation M Muzaffar Ahmed briefed the minister of various measures taken for the success and placed some sug-

During the discussion, the fisheries minister described the profit-earning trend of the organisation as a good symptom and emphasised the need for united efforts of the officials and staff of the organisation to sustain this tempo.

He said that the BFDC was formed primarily to strike a balance between supply and price of fish. But that situation had been changed due to decrease of fish production from the natural sources and expansion of planned pisciculture.

He stressed the need for starting production-oriented projects to make the organisation economically viable and instructed all the project-managers to submit their own recommendations to the ministry within two months in this re-

Rajshahi customs collects Tk 1.59 cr revenue

RAJSHAHI, July 24: Rajshahi Customs, Excise and VAT Collectorate collected about Tk 1.59 crore in revenue in the last financial year, some 50 per cent higher than that of previous fiscal, reports UNB.

This was disclosed in a divisional officers' meeting held at the Rajshahi Collectorate Bhaban yesterday.

Member of the National Board of Revenue (VAT) Saiful Islam Khan presided over the meeting, attended by Collector Mohammad Tajul Islam Additional Collector Helaluddin Ahmed, Joint Collector Nasiruddin Ahmed and divisional officers.

Official sources said Tk 97 crore of the total revenue came from VAT and excise sources and the remaining Tk 62 crore from customs duties.

Revenue from customs sources grew 122 per cent and from VAT and excise sources 25 per kent in 1993-94 over the previous year's turnover.

The progress was due largely to special drives and different administrative mea sures, the meeting was told.

Strict laws for protecting religion demanded

By Staff Correspondent Speakers at a seminar in the capital yesterday called for enhancing the punishment for blasphemous offences.

They suggested an amendment of the existing laws by extending its punishable measures from two years imprisonment to a life term or not less than 5 years imprison-

At the seminar on "The Freedom of Speech and Religious Feelings" held at the Jatiya Press Club auditorium, they observed that there must be restrictions on the freedom of speech because unlicenced freedom of expression was opposed to the country's rule of law.

Organised by the Centre for Human Rights, the seminar was addressed by Dr Ershadul Bari, the Dean of Law Faculty, Dhaka University. Chaired by Justice Ruhul Islam, it was also addressed by the Supreme Court lawyer Khandaker Mahbubuddin Ahmed, secretary general of the centre Abdur Razzak, Bar-at-Law, the New Nation editor Alamgir Mohiuddin and president of Mahila Samaj Kalyan Samity Dr Maliha Khatun.

In his key-note paper, Dr Ershadul Bari said punishment for the blasphemous offences should be enhanced to arrest any tendency to hurt religious sentiments.

Justice Ruhul Islam in his presidential speech noted that although the Constitution guaranteed the freedom of speech there were laws too to restrict this freedom. He said the people who believed in Islam could not allow any criticism of the holy Quran or support the demand for the revision of the holy book.

Barrister Abdur Razzak observed there were laws in every society to restrict the freedom of speech as well as to protect the religions. But the law in our Constitution was not sufficient to protect Islam, he pointed out.
