

**3 killed in tempo-truck collision in Ctg**

CHITTAGONG, July 25: Three people were killed when a tempo and truck collided near BTC gate at Bhatyari on Dhaka-Chittagong highway yesterday, reports UNB.

Tempo driver Dulal, 30, and its two male passengers, who could not be identified immediately, died on the spot.

Police said the Sitakundu bound tempo collided with the Chittagong bound truck as the tempo tried to take a passerbay at 12-30 pm.

Police seized the truck, but the driver fled the scene.

**People won't tolerate any conspiracy, Huda warns**

Information Minister Barister Nazmul Huda has warned that the people would not tolerate any conspiracy against the elected government, reports BSS.

He urged the Opposition not to threaten to launch movement in the streets against the government of the people and nationalist force.

The information minister was addressing as chief guest the district Chhatra Dal conference in Patuakhali Sunday at the Sher-e-Bangla auditorium.

Religious Affairs Minister M Keramat Ali, district BNP leaders Shahadat Hossain and M A Rob, Chhatra Dal leaders Nazimuddin Alam, Mesbahuddin, A B M Mosharraf Hossain, Zerin Khan, Rehana Akter, Mahbubul Huq Nannu and Anwar Hossain Sikder also addressed the function.

The information minister said the nationalist force, taking the people with them, would remain in the streets at present and in future, as they were in the past, to face conspiracy against democracy and people's rule in the country.

Huda said there is no provision for a caretaker government in the constitution and demand for such a government is completely undemocratic and unconstitutional.

He said no amendment could be brought to change the fundamental principles of the constitution even with the support of the two-thirds majority of members of Parliament.

He said those forces who had established a Parliament of Keramat Ali, district BNP leaders Shahadat Hossain and M A Rob, Chhatra Dal leaders Nazimuddin Alam, Mesbahuddin, A B M Mosharraf Hossain, Zerin Khan, Rehana Akter, Mahbubul Huq Nannu and Anwar Hossain Sikder also addressed the function.

Those three forces have again united now to go to power through anarchy and indiscipline under a weak and unaccountable caretaker government," he said, adding these three forces never believe in people's rule.

**Taslima issue 'Indian press distorted facts'**

The Deputy High Commissioner of Bangladesh in Calcutta Jahangir Saadat has said that facts about Taslima Nasreen were not being correctly presented in the Indian press, reports UNB.

Highly motivated and extraneous issues not relevant to the case were being highlighted in a deliberate attempt to malign Bangladesh," said Jahangir Saadat, the Bangladesh envoy.

In separate letters published in major dailies of Calcutta, including Ananda Bazar Patrika, Jugantar, Ajkal and Amrita Bazar Patrika, he argued that a criminal case had been filed against Nasreen for her alleged malicious public statements, outraging the religious feelings of the vast majority of the country.

He said Nasreen has been absconding due process of law, if she has not committed any criminal mischief, it is for her to prove her innocence before the court of law.

Th Deputy High Commissioner said unlike many western countries, Bangladesh does not have any blasphemy law, but a law under which Taslima Nasreen was being prosecuted, is a secular law giving non-discriminatory protection of all faiths.

Her public statements are now under the scrutiny of the normal laws, but he regretted that a section of the Indian press have been trying to create an impression that Nasreen is being persecuted, deliberately to create confusion about the clear line between legal prosecution and political persecution.

The bandits snatched Tk 37,000 and valuable at gun point and fled.
