Fertility rate declines,
BDHS report says

The pace of fertility has declined significantly in Bangladesh with the increase of contraceptive use in recent years, reports UNB.

According to Bangladesh Demographic and Health Survey (BDHS) 1993-94, the total fertility rate (TFR) is 3.4 children per woman, much lower than 4.3 found in a contraceptive prevalence survey in 1991.

The BDH survey was presented at a seminar in the city yesterday, participated by government officials, demographers, researchers, planners and representatives from different NGOs and development partners.

National Institute for Population Research and Training (NIPORT) conducted the survey across the country with the

help of Mitra and Associates, a private research firm, from November 1993 to March 1994.

During the survey, 9,640 women and 3,284 men of both urban and rural areas in the country's five divisions were interviewed.

Preliminary report of the survey says that some 45 per cent of married women in the country are currently using a contraceptive method. More women are using modern methods (36 per cent) than traditional methods (8 per cent).

The contraceptive prevalence rate has more than doubled over the past decade, from 19 to 45 per cent of married women, and the use of modern methods has grown ever faster than overall use.
