Requirements/conditions of application for one-way travel grant for studies abroad
1. Any student who secured admission for studies in foreign university/institution for the current year that is between the 1st January and the 31st December, 1994 may apply for the Sweden-Bangladesh Trust Fund assistance.
2. The application of a student with third class/division shall not be considered.
3. In case of failure to show any valid reason for any break of study, applications shall not be considered.
4. The application submitted without due requirements shall not be considered.
5. Any applicant who has availed of the travel grant money earlier shall not be eligible to apply for the assistance for the second time.
6. Travel grant money shall be reimbursed/paid to the applicant or his authorised representative after he has got admitted and travelled and on submission of the following papers:
(a) Applicant's passport, entry visa and the original copy of air ticket or its attested copy.
(b) A certificate of his studentship at the foreign educational institution.
(c) The applicant's letter authorising his representative to draw the travel grant money and the specimen signature of his representative attested by the applicant in the said letter and a copy of his (representative's) passport size photo attested also by the applicant.
7. The application along with necessary documents/papers shall be submitted to the undersigned's office (Room No. 8, Block No. 15, Economic Relations Division, Ministry of Finance, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar, Dhaka) on or by the 31st August, 1994.

Jamaat criticises govt for failing to create new jobs

Jamaat-e-Islami yesterday criticised the government for its failure in reopening the closed mills and factories and creating new jobs, reports UNB.

The party's central working committee at a meeting with its Ameer Prof Golam Azam in the chair expressed concern over the selling out of profitable industries in the name of denationalisation and the termination of thousands of industrial workers and employees.

The working committee protesting and condemning indiscriminate "disinvestment," a resolution of the meeting said. It attributed wastage, inefficiency, corrupt administration for incurring loss in the industrial units.

The meeting said without taking effective steps for industrialisation, the government is making the economy dependent on others by closing down mills and factories.

Lecture on East German women held

Dr Shamsul Islam Khan of the Department of International Relations, University of Dhaka, gave a lecture Thursday on the state of East German economy after the unification of Germany, and how it affects the life of East German working women, specially the professional ones.

Dr. S I Khan said that there was a sense of political and social euphoria in East Germany after July 1990 but East German economy had been primitive compared to that of West Germany and after the unification GDR lost its entire market.

Dr. Khan said that "Short-term Work Zero Hour" was introduced by which people, specially women, were encouraged to stay at home and get a salary. The women looked for other jobs or education, but in vain.

He pointed out that the number of women in East Germany in education, health, social service, industrial manufacture and trade had once been high.

He said that with the cheap day-care centre being removed in East Germany after the unification, the number of divorces and psychological counselling went up in East Germany, and both blue and white colored women workers suffered.

Organised by the Info Time, the lecture programme was held at the German Cultural Centre in the city.
