FARIDPUR, Aug 6: A five day long training course on adult education concluded here recently.

It may be mentioned here that fifteen adult education centres, ten for male and five for female have been opened within the municipal area. In each of the centres there are thirty students and one teacher.

Sponsored by the district administration, the entire project is being financed by zila parishad and CCDB jointly.

## Damurhuda Thana Health Complex in Chuadanga beset with problems

CHUADANGA, Aug 6: The Thana Health Complex at Chitalia under Damurhuda Thana of Chuadanga a district is beset with a host of problems. As a result the people of the area do not have better amenities of medical treatment in it.

The health complex is situated over one mile away from Damurhuda thana headquarters where there is no proper arrangement for the security of the patients as well as the staff including doctors, compounders.

At present only 10 sick beds are available to the patients for use in health complex. The dearth of mattresses, pillows and bed covers is acute. Consequently it poses a problem to the authority to provide accommodation when there is rush of patients in the health complex.

Besides, the health complex faces shortage of surgical appliances.

The absence of ambulance is another problem is the movement of serious patients

to district hospital for providing better treatment.

The health complex also runs short of the requisite number of doctors. Besides the posts of lady doctors have been lying vacant for a pretty long time causing much inconvenience to the female patients.

The absence of proper water supply system also poses a problem to the patients and working staff. The X-ray plant which was introduced to a long time ago in the health complex goes out of order frequently causing untold miseries to the common patients. The scarcity of drugs in the hospital is also acute. Apart from a few tablets no other drugs are available in the health complex. The patients are to buy their drugs from outside.

In view of the above, the people of Damurhuda thana expect the authorities concerned to ensure appropriate steps to improve the condition of the health complex with all amenities for the better medical facilities of people.

## Temporary suspension of engineers ordered

BAGERHAT, Aug 6: Agriculture, Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control Minister M Majid-ul-Haq directed the authorities concerned for temporary suspension of the engineers involved in the projects to protect the Moreganj Thana Health Centre and A C Pilot High School from erosion of the River Panghuchi in Bagerhat for substandard design and low quality work, reports BSS.

The Agriculture Minister accompanied by Foreign Minister, ASM Mostafizur Rahman visited the sites of river erosion and protection work, at different places of Bagerhat district. Parliament members Mufti Moulana Abdus Sattar and Syeda Nargis Ali also accompanied them during the visit.

Majid-ul-Haq had directed to prepare a project and implement on an emergency basis to save the centre and the school from the erosion of the river during his visit of the area last year. He expressed his dissatisfaction at the standard of the design and works during his visit.

The Irrigation Minister ordered a high-level enquiry into the matter and submit a report within ten days.

The minister also directed the engineers of Water Development Board to take steps for excavation of the 28-km Bholia river dried up five years back or excavate river or to take other technical steps to save the people from the attack of tigers of neighbouring Sundarbans man-grove forest.

## Hasina legalised Jamaat, Ershad by joining '86 polls, says Tariq



#### Sarbaraha Party activist held

BARISAL, Aug 6: Barisal Pourashava has undertaken a programme to set up automatic traffic signal lights at six main road-crossings in the town, reports UNB.
