**No early elections: Oli**

KHULNA, Aug 7: Government leaders at a rally today made it clear that election will not be held even a day ahead of the schedule, reports UNB.

"Election will not be held even a day ahead of due date... the government would not bow down to any illogical demand and sidetrack the current development process," Communications Minister Oli Ahmed told a rally at the Rupsha ferryhat.

The opposition parties have been boycotting parliament on their demand for election under a caretaker government.

Oli said the government would only respect people's desire and aspiration. Speaking at the rally, Speaker Shaikh Razzak Ali

said, "The people are very much politically conscious now... it is very difficult to bluff them," and added the country has progressed a lot in last three years.

The speaker, however, said cooperation of all quarters could have expedited the pace of development.

Khulna City Corporation Mayor Sheikh Tayebur Rahman and Syeda Nargis Ali, MP, also spoke. Khulna city BNP president M Nurul Islam presided.

On the demand for construction of a bridge over the Rupsha river, the Communications Minister said his ministry would complete all survey works related to construction of the bridge by December this year.
