Dacoity in N'ganj

NARAYANGANJ, Aug 8: Dacoits looted goods worth about Tk 1.25 lakh, including cash, from a house at Kashipur of Fatullah thana Sunday midnight, reports UNB.

A group of armed and masked men, numbering 5 to 6, stormed into the house of Sardar Mohammad Hossain, a banker, by breaking the grill of the verandah and took the key of the locker from the him.

They looted cash Tk 30,000 and 14 tolas of gold and other valuables at gun point and fled the scene.

A case has been filed with Fatullah thana.

A four-member delegation of the public accounts committee of the Bangladesh Jatiya Sangsads arrived in Seoul Sunday on a three-day visit to South Korea, according to a message received here, reports BSS.

Led by L K Siddique, MP, chairman of the committee, the delegation was received at the airport by the local officials. The Bangladesh ambassador to South Korea, A K Fazlur Rahman was also present.

During their stay, the delegation will meet chairman of the special committee on budget and accounts of the National Assembly, Kim Yong Tae, member of the National Assembly of ROK and chairman of Bangladeshi-Korean Parliamentarians Friendship Association, Moon Chang Mo. They will also call on the Speaker of the National Assembly.

Other members of the delegation are Anwar Hussain Chowdhury MP, Mesbahuddin Khan MP and Dr Fazle Rabbi MP.

Restoration of shops near Bihari camps demanded

Leader of the stranded Pakistanis Nasim Khan yesterday demanded restoration of the shops near Bihari camps in Mohammadpur which were demolished by police on Sunday, reports UNB.

In a statement, he claimed camps and shops owned by the stranded Pakistanis are legal and recognised by the government. He protested the eviction of the shops by authorities concerned without examining necessary papers and documents.

Khan claimed 50 people, including a minor boy, were injured and belongings and valuables worth about Tk 1 lakh were damaged during the eviction.

He sent telegrams to the Prime Minister, Foreign Minister, Relief and LGRD Ministers and the Pakistan High Commissioner in Bangladesh, demanding immediate enquiry to find out the facts and allow re-establishment of the demolished shops.
