The speakers also criticised the government for selling out the public sector industries at a throw away price and alleged that the government has been doing all these as per the prescription of the World Bank and the IMF to make the country a market of the industrialised nations.

Govt to sanction Tk 35cr to palli Karma foundation

The government yesterday decided to sanction Taka 35 crore to the Palli Karma Sahayak Foundation, a voluntary organisation for rural employment, increasing its fund at Taka 75 crore for disbursement of credit among the people, reports BSS.

The decision was taken at a meeting held at the conference room of the Ministry of Finance, with Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman in the chair. The Palli Karma Sahayak Foundation has so far disbursed Taka 18.5 crore this year as credit among the people at the highest ceiling of Taka 5000 per head since its operation began in 1990.

The foundation operates its credit disbursement programmes through the locally based voluntary organisations at different parts in the country. At present about 100 NGOs are associated with it. The Finance Minister urged all concerned to make the government's pro-active drive of distributing credit among the people a success. "We could make a miracle in the economy, if we could give credit to the people for fishing, poultry, dairy and other small agro-based activities," Saifur said.

Obituary

Begum Asia Ahmed Chowdhury, wife of Lt Commander Ahmed Ali Chowdhury (ret'd), died of cancer at the King Abdul Aziz Hospital at Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, early yesterday. She was 66, reports UNB. Begum Chowdhury left behind four sons, two daughters and a host of relatives and admirers to mourn her death. Her body is expected to reach in Dhaka tomorrow. The namaz-e-janaza of late Asia Chowdhury will be held at the New DOHS Mosque at Mohakhali on the day after Juma prayers.

She will be buried at her family graveyard at Shilghat village in Dhaka Dhakshin of Sylhet.

Dairy, poultry units to be exempted from income tax

The government has decided to exempt the owners of local dairy and poultry industries from income tax up to year 2000, reports UNB.

The Minister for Fisheries and Livestock Abdullah Al-Noman said this while he was presiding over a meeting of the Bangladesh Livestock Development Parishad Tuesday.

The meeting emphasised adequate supply of cattle-feed for the development of livestock and decided to strengthen research for production of feed by various cheaper agricultural by-products.

Utilisation of government khas land to produce green grass and supply of refrigerators, motor cycles and kit boxes to every thana for strengthening artificial insemination programmes also came up in the discussion.

The Parishad consists of the members from the following ministries - Fisheries and Livestock, Finance, Agricultural, Local Government and Cooperatives, Land, Food, Environment and Forest, Commerce, Industries, Energy and Mineral Resources and Youth and Sports including Agricultural University, Bangladesh Bank and dairy and poultry farmers associations.
