

ICDDR,B team back home

The emergency medical team of International Centre for Diarrhoeal Disease Research, Bangladesh (ICDDR,B) returned home from Rwanda yesterday after two weeks, reports BSS.

The team evaluated the situation in Goma, Zaire and the surrounding areas where millions of refugees have fled from neighbouring Rwanda. The team then provided briefings and technical assistance to the international relief agencies operating field hospitals to deal with the cholera epidemic. The most rewarding indication of their success was the reduction of fatality rates in the field hospitals, from around 20 per cent to less than 2 per cent.

In addition, the team was able to work in close collaboration with UNICEF and the government of Zaire to establish a large diarrhoeal disease treatment centre in Goma and train the staff working there.

Breast feeding can save Tk 419 cr a year

Breast feeding can save hard earned foreign currency of about Tk 419 crore spent every year for importing powder milk, reports UNB.

Monzoor-ul-Karim, Special Adviser Nutrition, UNICEF Bangladesh, disclosed this while he was addressing the fourth installation ceremony of Inner Wheel Club of Metropolitan Dhaka, at a local hotel yesterday.

The UNICEF advisor said about 93 per cent children have been suffering from malnutrition in the country, adding that the main cause of the malnutrition is lack of proper knowledge.

He said there is no alternative to breast milk for the newborn in the first five months.

He called upon the educated mothers as well as the voluntary organisations like Inner Wheel Club to create awareness for breast feeding.

Quoting the holy Quran, he said the mothers could give breast milk to their children for two years after the birth.

Referring to a recent survey he said about 95 per cent working mothers cannot give their child breast feeding as they have no facilities in their working place.

The function was also addressed by incoming president of the club Nazma Khan, its outgoing president Zeenat Islam, IIF Board Member Farhat Rahim, national representative Dilruba Ahmed and chairman of Inner Wheel District 328 Lutfia Islam.
