Stronger cooperation among Muslim countries sought

Religious Affairs Minister Muhammad Keramat Ali, now in Egypt to attend a conference on Islamic affairs, called for strengthening cooperation among the Muslim countries to combat the challenges of new international trends, reports UNB.

He made the call at the sixth general conference of the supreme council for Islamic Affairs, held in the historic city of Alexandria, Egypt, this week.

The four-day conference was attended by over 30 minis-

ters of religious affairs of Muslim countries and representatives of 80 Islamic organisations from all parts of the world and also the Arab League, said a delayed message received in the city yesterday.

Keramat Ali, who visited Egypt August 14-20, was chosen the first speaker to deliver a key-note speech on 'The Role of Islamic Ummah Towards the New International Trends'. This was one of the 15 research papers selected for presentation during the conference.

Keramat Ali held exclusive meetings with the Egyptian Minister for Waqfs and head of the Supreme Council for Islamic Affairs Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ali Mahgoub, the grand Imam Sheikh Gad Al Haque Ali Gad Al Haque, Rector of Al-Azhar and chairman of the conference.

214 arrested

Police rounded up 214 people, including 20 wanted criminals, from different parts of the city in the last two days, reports UNB.

The arrested also included one charged with murder, four were held under the anti-terrorism law, three under the Arms Act, ten under the Special Powers Act, eight under the Explosives Act and three accused of stealing.
