11 pirates held in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Aug 23: A special team of the port police last night arrested eleven pirates from the bay, near Goira of Anwara thana and recovered a huge quantity of different kinds of stolen goods, reports BSS.

According to port police, the team acting on secret information chased a machinised boat at the sea and managed to arrest a pirate. On the basis of the confession of the arrested person, police later rounded up ten pirates from different villages of Anwara thana.

The pirates confessed that they were operating in Sandwip and Kutubdia areas.

The team also recovered some stolen robes and other goods from a godown at Ashraf Ali Road in the city, valued at about taka three and a half lakh, the sources said.

A case was filed with port police.

Tk 17.30 cr Swiss grant for rural development

Bangladesh will receive a grant of 6,650 million Swiss Franc (approx. Tk 17.30 crore) from Switzerland for a rural development project under an agreement signed here on Monday, reports UNB.

A B M Golam Mousa Bhuiyan, Deputy Secretary at the Economic Relations Division, and Ruth Zumbuhl, Charge d'Affaires at the Swiss embassy in Dhaka, signed on behalf of their respective governments.

The grant assistance provided under the agreement will be spent for the project styled, "Rural Development Project-6: Infrastructure (2nd phase) old Dhaka district (Manikganj district)."

The project will be implemented by the Local Government Engineering Department of the Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives (LGRD).

The main objective of the project is to develop the feeder roads connecting the growth centres with thana headquarters or arterial road system to establish linkages between the growth centres and the thana and district HQs to facilitate flow of production inputs, goods and services in and out of the growth centres.

Other objectives are: development of markets for augmenting economic and commercial activities of the area, and creation of employment opportunities in the short run from the project construction activities and in the long run from road maintenance works.

Dist level science exhibition from October 1

The district level exhibition and competition of the 18th National Science and Technology Week will be held all over the country from October 1 to 15, reports BSS.

This was decided at a meeting of the national organising committee of the science week held at the conference room of the Science and Technology Ministry with the State Minister Prof M A Mannan in the chair.

96 held in city

Police rounded up 96 people, including 27 wanted criminals, from different parts of the city yesterday, reports UNB.

The arrested also included three charged with murder, three held under the Arms Act, five under the Special Powers Act, one accused of kidnapping, one of robbery and six for stealing.

Obituary

Shafiqur Rahman, a senior advocate of Bangladesh Supreme Court, died of cardio-respiratory failure and cerebral haemorrhage at his residence Monday night. He was 76, reports BSS.

He left behind two sons, one daughter and a host of relatives.

Shafiqur Rahman was born in a respectable Muslim family of Saturasharif village of Akhaura thana under Brahmanbaria district.

He participated in various social and political movements.

His namaz-e-janaza was held at Baitul Mukarram after Jhor prayers yesterday and he was buried at Banani graveyard.

Qulqhwani will be held on Friday at his residence at 68/A, Jigatala after Asr prayers.

UNB adds: President Abdur Rahman Biswas yesterday expressed his profound sorrow at the death of Shafiqur Rahman.

In a condolence message, the President said Advocate Shafiqur Rahman was a learned and devoted lawyer. In his death, he said, the legal profession has lost one of its distinguished members.

Cargo canopy at ZIA opens

Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman formally opened the newly built air cargo canopy at the Zia International Airport yesterday, reports BSS.

The 30,000 square feet air-side canopy was built to accommodate the increased volume of cargo in the wake of the phenomenal growth in the country's import-export trade.

The 400-ton capacity canopy will also accommodate the huge cargo lying in the open air outside the cargo complex.

During a visit to the cargo complex a few months back Saifur Rahman had expressed dissatisfaction over the huge stockpile of valuable cargo under the open sky.

Speaking on the occasion the Finance Minister said the increased volume of imports and exports during the last few years is indicative of the growth in the country's economic activities.

The Finance Minister urged the Customs and Civil Aviation Authority to together find out ways and means to simplify the procedure for expeditious clearance of imports. He also directed the authorities concerned to increase the rent for warehousing so that importers clear their cargo promptly. He also stressed the need for expansion of the protected space for export handling.

State Minister for Civil Aviation Abdul Mannan, who was also present said, in future shippers would be advised not to bring their export cargo more than 48 hours before the scheduled shipment time.

The meeting was informed that daily an average of 100 tons of imports are handled at the airport of which 50 tons are cleared every day.

The cumulative stock of cargo awaiting clearance is 700 tons and another 115 tons whose clearance time had expired are awaiting auction.

Later, the Finance Minister visited the under construction boarding bridges to see for himself the progress of work.

State Minister for Civil Aviation Abdul Mannan, Secretary of the Civil Aviation Ministry, chairman, Civil Aviation Authority, accompanied the Finance Minister.

3 opposition parties out to foil uplift efforts: Anwar

Shipping Minister M K Anwar yesterday accused the three main opposition parties of making desperate bid to obstruct the development efforts of the present government.

The desperate bid of the opposition trio, he said, comes at a time when fruits of the BNP government's programme for socio-economic development started reaching the people.

The minister was addressing a public meeting at Kalir- bazar Technical High School ground in Jagatpur Uttar Union of Daudkandi thana.

Anwar said the development programmes are being implemented to fulfil the election pledges of BNP as part of its commitment and for implementation of the 19-point programmes.

"BNP does not believe in the politics of hollow slogans or false promises, it believes in the politics of development and production."
