## Rab demands polls under neutral interim govt

Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal (JSD-Rab) leader ASM Abdur Rab yesterday demanded national elections under a neutral interim government led by the 'ombudsman', reports UNB.

He suggested that an acceptable personality be appointed as ombudsman, a post provided for in Bangladesh Constitution.

The JSD Secretary General told a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club yesterday morning that the Prime Minister should hand over power to the head of the interim government for holding a free and fair elections in response to a national demand.

Branding the government as 'autocratic', he said it has lost its moral right to stay in power for failure to fulfil its election pledges and deepening economic crisis.

Rab stressed the need for introducing identity cards for voters and enacting laws to enhance powers of the Election Commission for conducting elections in a free and fair atmosphere.

Party President Nur Alam Ziku and Organising Secretary Abdul Maleq Ratan were among those present at the press conference.

Information Minister Nazmul Huda said yesterday that the members of various mass media could play a significant role in increasing fish resources through highlighting the beneficial as well as detrimental aspects of rearing fish through modern and scientific methods, reports BSS.

He was inaugurating as chief guest a 'national dialogue' on the role of mass media in increasing fish resources, organised by the Press Institute of Bangladesh (PIB) at its conference hall in the city.



Among others, PIB chairman Gazi Shamsur Rahman and Director General Dr Tauhidul Anwar also spoke. Shrimp expert Dr Mahmudul Karim presented the key-note paper.

Nazmul Huda said that the mass media could contribute much towards motivating the people to make successful various programmes taken by the government for the expansion of fish resources.

Huda underscored the need for highlighting various detrimental aspects of fish culture like the use of current nets or hauling of fishfries. He suggested that the common people and fish culturists could be inspired through massive campaign through posters leaflets and other publicity means.

Huda reiterated that the Ministry of Fisheries should have its special publicity cell comprising departmental experts, radio and television representatives and journalists of various newspapers and news agencies.




