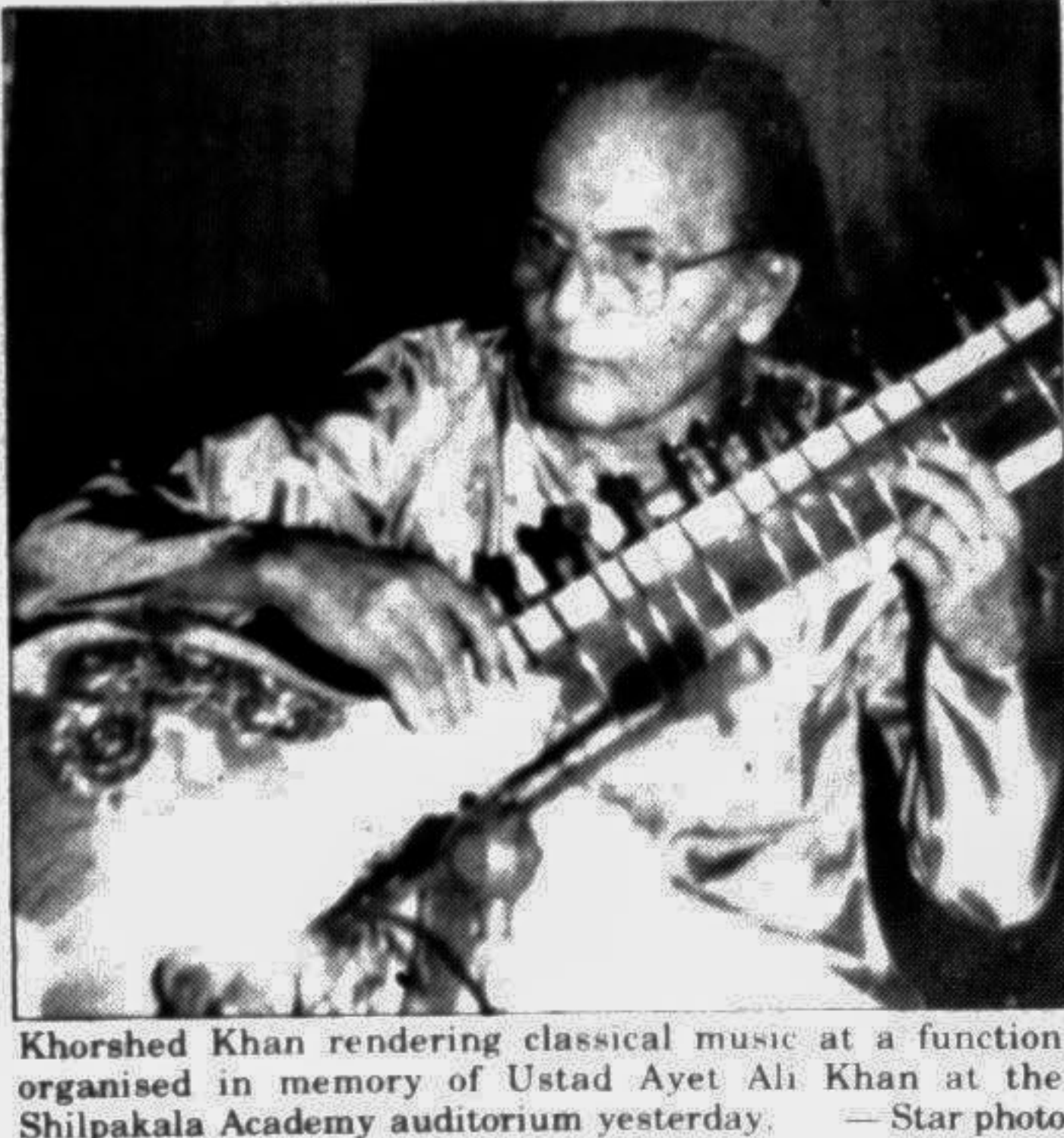

House rent for Hajj pilgrims '95 must be paid by Oct 30

The government has taken an early step to hire residential accommodation to ease the housing problem of Bangladeshi Hajjis in Saudi Arabia during the coring Hajj season, an official handout said in Dhaka Thursday night, reports BSS.
Able Bangladeshi Muslims intending to perform Hajj in 1995 under government management and willing to stay in government-hired houses in Makkah have been requested to deposit Taka 16,000 (Equal to Saudi Riyal 1,500) with any scheduled bank by October 30 this year.
The handout said that the house-rent, to be deposited in advance, will be adjusted with the overall Hajj cost later. The rent has been fixed on estimation and may vary with the real rent.
The cost for each Bangladeshi performing Hajj this year under government management was Taka 83, 815. This may remain the same or may be a little more next year, the handout said.
Those wanting to perform Hajj without depositing house rent in advance will have to procure their visas from the Saudi embassy in Dhaka on their own and arrange their own accommodation in Saudi Arabia, as in the previous years, the handout said. The government will not be responsible for their accommodation.
Intending women pilgrims have been advised to deposit their money alongwith the 'Muhrim' as per the Sharia law, the handout said.

'Zia formed BNP to achieve socio-economic emancipation

Turning to the present situation prevailing in the political horizon of the country Prof Chowdhury said that some kind of concern has developed among the political circles over the long-boycott of parliament by the opposition. The government, the opposition and the nation as a whole were eager to see that the problem is solved through dialogue and discussion.

US professor visits IUBAT
