Call to observe birth anniversary of Abul Mansur at Bangla Academy

Speakers at a seminar in the city yesterday called for observing the birth anniversary of litterateur, journalist, satirist and politician Abul Mansur Ahmad at the Bangla Academy each year and publishing his complete works.

"We have not learnt to respect ourselves, not to mention a great personality like Abul Mansur Ahmad. I urge the Bangla Academy to organise programmes on him and publish his works for the new generations," said Commerce Minister M Shamsul Islam.

Speaking as the chief guest at the seminar held to mark the 96th anniversary of the birth of the prolific political writer, Shamsul Islam said, "Mansur Ahmad is the first writer to separate the cultural identity of the Bangladesh from those of the West Bengal."

The seminar, organised by the Bangladesh Sahitya Sangskriti Kendra was chaired by its president Mahbub Anam, also the editor of The Bangladesh Times and addressed by Dewan Mohammad Azraf, Nazrul Institute executive director Md Mahfuzullah, Jobayda Gulshan Ara and Al Majahedi.

Mahbub Anam, recalling the literary contributions of Mansur Ahmad said, "He was one of the first few authors to receive the Bangla Academy award but later the academy totally neglected him."

Mahfuzullah said, Abul Mansur was exceptionally creative adding that his main driving force was a passion to build a healthy and progressive society.

"You can feel his passion behind his satires in which he mercilessly attacked the narrowness of politicians and leaders, exploitation of religion and oddities of the social system," Mahfuzullah pointed out.

Dewan Md Azraf termed Mansur as a leader of the Bangalee renaissance who filled the vacuum in the Bengali literature after poet Kazi Nazrul Islam.

'Jesus 71' nominated for Granada award

Bangladeshi film "Jesus 71" has been nominated for Granada award at the recently concluded Edinburgh Film Festival, according to a message received in the city yesterday, reports BSS.

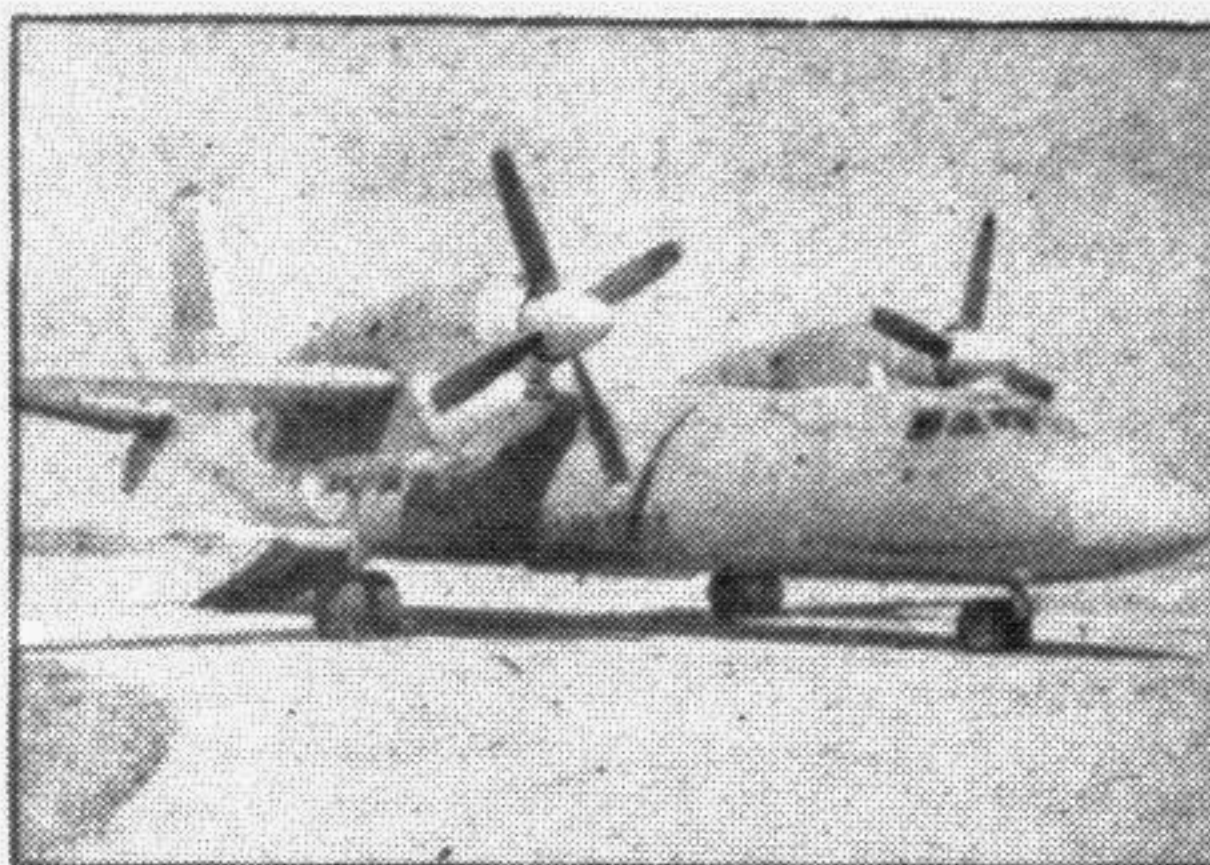
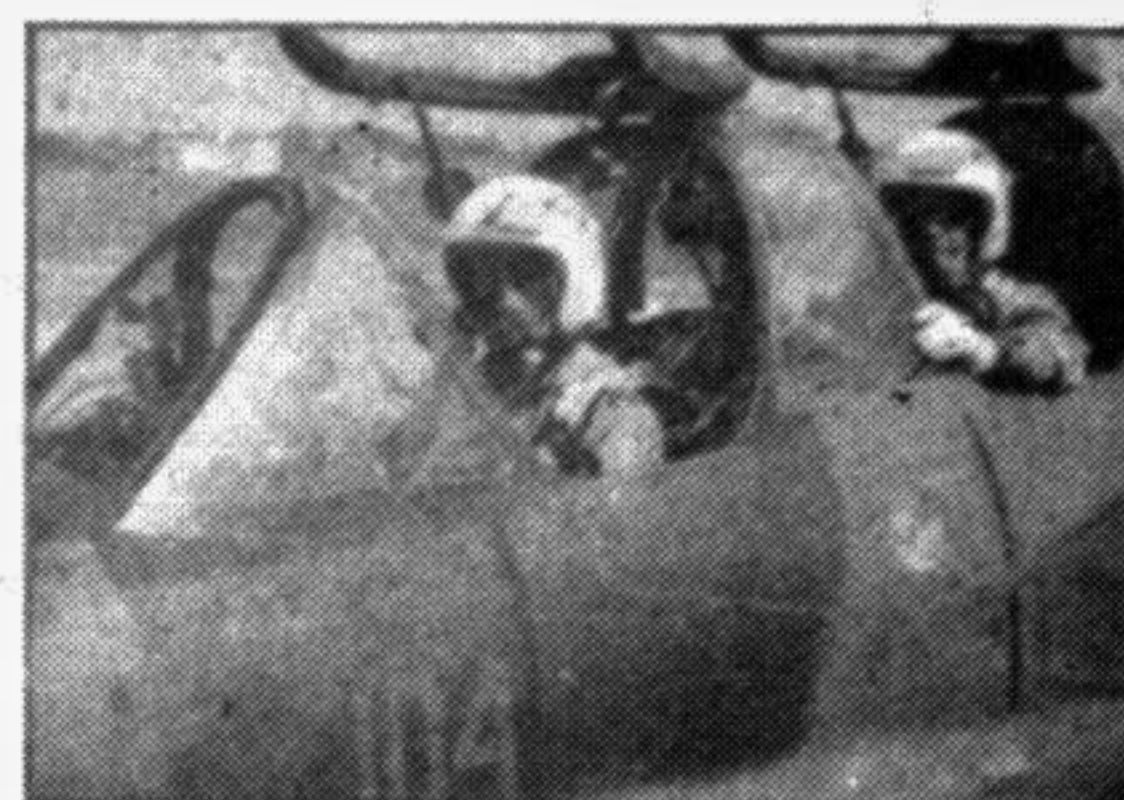
