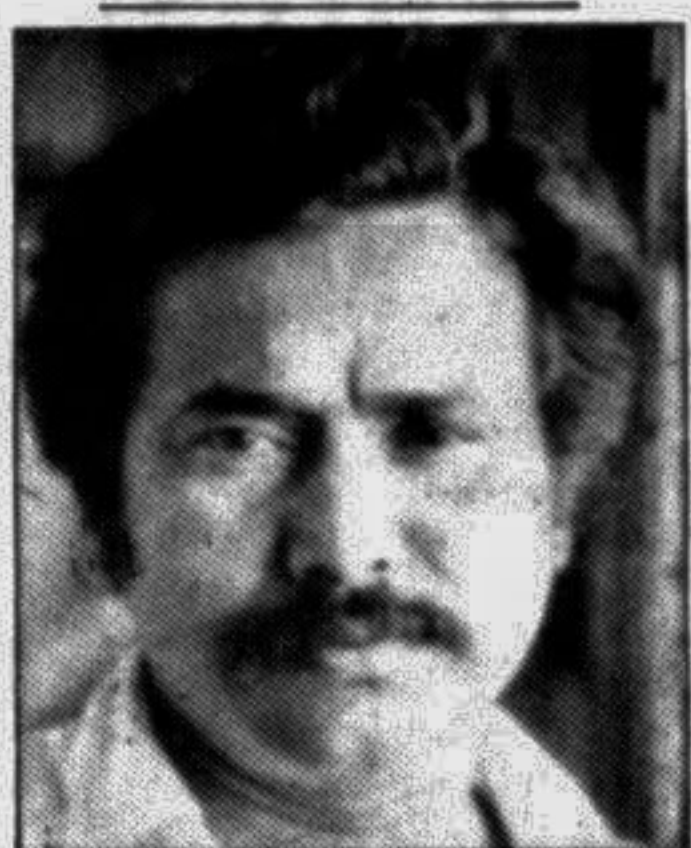
Rafiq to listen to city dwellers' problems again

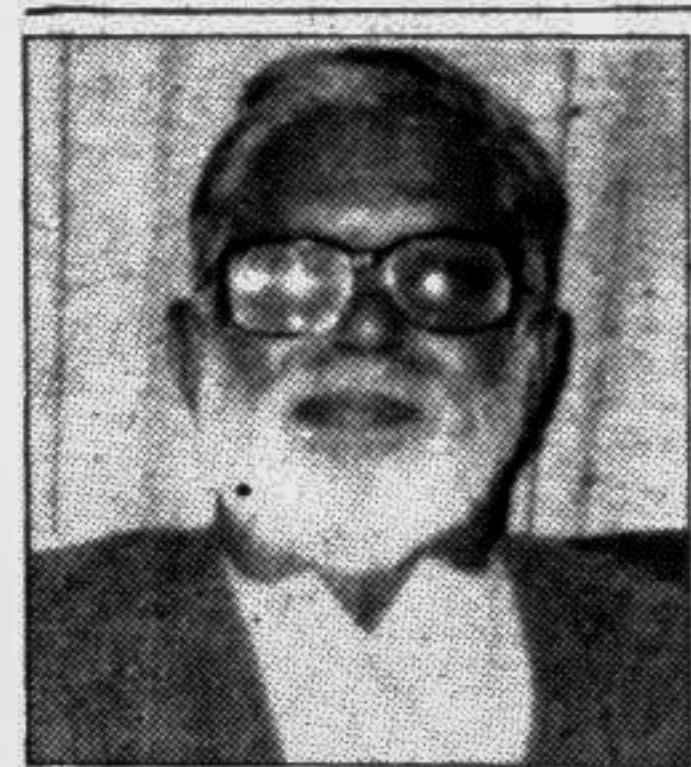

iv) Acquaint them with first hand knowledge on family planning.

MONITORING AND EVALUATION:

Centres are being evaluated from the weekly report of supervisors. The case is same with block, union and thana levels. With the help of INFEP, monitoring formats have already been developed and are on use in the field.

SUPERVISION AND IMPLEMENTATION:

For smooth functioning and implementation of the programme, each administrative tier has one implementation committee and one executive committee.
