

Minister tells JS

10 sugar mills identified for privatisation

The government is reconsidering the issue of privatisation of sugar industries. State Minister for Industries Lutfar Rahman Khan told the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday, reports

Making a statement on a call attention notice moved by K J Hamida Khanam (Women-20) on urgent matters of important public interest on sugar industries, the state minister said that out of 16 sugar mills, the government had identified 10 mills for privatisation. He said tenders for privatisation of Shympur and Panchagar Sugar Mills had been floated but the decision had been taken in this regard

He said that the existing sugar mills in the country could produce two lakh tonnes of sugar per annum while the demand was 3.50 lakh tonnes and the shortfall is met from

He said due to increase of price of sugar in 1994, the government had liberalised import of sugar recently. The private sector had opened LCs for 2.40 lakh tonnes which was much above the annual shortfall. He said 52,000 tonnes of this sugar had already reached the country and the rest was in

the pipeline. He said that the crushing season of sugarcane would start on October and to serve the interest of the sugarcane growers as well as the industry, the government had decided to control again the import of sugar.

He said in 1993, three LCs. were opened for import of 37,500 metric tons of sugar and 26,000 tonnes of it had already reached the country and the rest was expected to reach

Hamida Khanam in her notice said that the sugar industry was the verge of collapse due to the indecision of the government regarding privatisation of the mills. She said. this is also creating frustration among the workers and employees in the industry.
