NGOs to get technical assistance from C'wealth

Chief Emeke Anyaoku, the Commonwealth Secretary General, yesterday said that the Marlborough House would collaborate with the NGOs in the field of technical assistance, reports UNB.

Chief Anyaoku, who arrived here on Thursday on a five-day official visit, said that an NGO division which had already been set up at the Commonwealth Secretariat last year, was now engaged in liaison work.

The NGOs, Chief Anyaoku observed, have proved to be 'very effective at the grassroots level.' The Commonwealth Secretary General made the remarks during a visit to the headquarters of Bangladesh Rural Advancement Committee (BRAC) where he had a meeting with its Executive Director FH Abed.

Chief Anyaoku informed that his secretariat would start collaboration with the NGOs under its technical assistance programme as soon as more funds are available.

During the two-hour luncheon meeting, Abed gave a detailed account of the multi-

sectoral activities of BRAC, particularly in the fields of rural development and credit, non-formal primary education and women's health and development.

He said that eleven lakh people, 70 per cent of whom are women, became BRAC group members. At present there are nine lakh borrowers of BRAC's rural credit programme.

'Besides, 700 restaurants and 1,500 grocery shops are owned and run by the BRAC's women group members in the rural areas. BRAC has also taken up an ambitious scheme of planting four crore Mulberry trees in the country by 1997.'

Abed told the Commonwealth chief executive the scheme would not only enable Bangladesh to produce 1,200 tons of silk per year but also provide employment to five lakh women.

BML's concern The Bangladesh Muslim League (BML) expressed concern over the 'illegal entry' of some Indian ships into Bangladeshi territory, reports UNB.

They also criticised the government for not giving due importance to the pending problems including Farraka barrage, Shanti Bahini and smuggled Indian goods.

Call to lift sanctions against Libya The Bangladesh-Libyan Arab Friendship Association urged the United Nations (UN) to lift its diplomatic and air sanctions imposed against Libya, says a press release.

The association adopted number of resolutions at a meeting held Friday at a city hotel to mark the 25th founding anniversary of the Al-Fateh Revolution of Libyan Jamahiriya.

The speakers also criticised the role of the western countries on the Iraq and Bosnia-Herzegovina issues. They alleged that the Western World was always playing double standards when the Muslims became victimised in every corner of the world.

Speakers termed the embargo as a human right violation against the innocent people of Libya.
