

Corrigendum Notice

In the notice inviting application for pre-qualification of contractors/firms vide Rajshahi Water Dev. Circle's Memo No. 2364(50) 5E-64 dt. 28-8-1994 the following amendments are made:

1. In Clause No. 3 of the notice inviting applications where it was mentioned that contractors/firms who successfully completed hydraulic structure in single contract costing Tk 100.00 lac or more for work in SI 1(a) and Tk 80.00 lac or more for SI 1(b) are to be substituted for Tk 150.00 lac for the work of SI 1(a) and Tk 125.00 lac for the work of SI 1(b) to consider eligibility for submitting application.

2. Contractors/firms who have successfully completed construction of hydraulic structures as per specification and within scheduled time in the last 10 (ten) years are eligible to submit applications for pre-qualification but evaluation of pre-qualification will be made based on performance of works completed during the last 5 (five) years.



Deputy Minister for Health Sirajul Hoque and high officials of the ministry were present on the occasion.

The speakers pledged to gear up the movement to implement the Padma Bridge.

3 HYV pulses developed

The Bangladesh Atomic Agriculture Research Institute has developed high yielding varieties of three kinds of pulses - Mugh, Mashkalai and Chhola, reports UNB.

The new varieties of pulses will produce 15 to 20 times higher than the existing ones.

This was disclosed at a meeting of the council of directors of the institute at the conference room of the Agriculture Ministry yesterday with Agriculture and Water Resources Minister M Majid-ul Hag in the chair.

The meeting was informed that the institute is presently carrying out research on developing and identifying high yielding varieties of the Aus and Boro paddy, jute and some vegetables by using atomic and solar energy. The minister said produc-

tion of such high vielding varieties of pulses should be increased in the country for attaining self-sufficiency in pulses like other food grains.

Majidul Haq said prior approval of the ministry would be required for marketing or supply of fertilizer or any variety of crops developed at the Bangladesh Atomic Agriculture Institute or any other research institute to the farmers.




