"We in Hiroshima want everyone to enjoy the Asian Games," said Minoru Shlimamura, a site official of the Games Organising Committee. "The important thing is that they feel the atmosphere."

The plea was made in a press bulletin which said, "We can not respond to your individual asking directly made to us." But the committee message ended some helpful advice: "For further information, Operations department" and also left a telephone number.

The granite came from the pavement of the city hall destroyed in the atomic bomb explosion that killed some 140,000 people. Hiraoka told the Olympic Council of Asia meeting that the gifts might be a reminder of "The excitement and shared desire for peace generated by the Hiroshima Games."

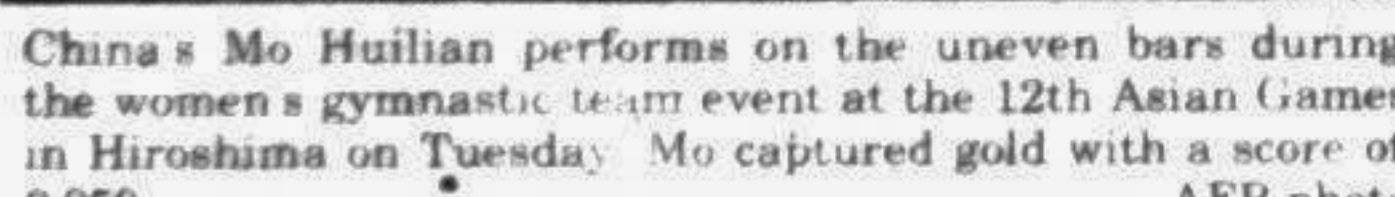

Japan's Satoshi Iwabuchi and Ryu Tsujino beat Indonesia's Wiryawan Sugiharto and Doni Susetio 6-2, 6-4 in the doubles.



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
