Different types of gorgeous sarees drew the attention of all yesterday at the opening day of the seven-day Banarasi exhibition at the Shilpakala Academy art gallery, reports UNB.

Six renowned Banarasi saree makers of Mirpur participated in the exhibition which was inaugurated by State Minister for Textile Abdul Mannan. Bangladesh Handloom Board organised the exhibition.

The traditional Banarasi, specially used for matrimonial purposes is inextricably linked with Bengali culture. None can even think a marriage without a Banarasi saree, said a visitor.

Some 991 handloom families are engaged in these industries particularly based in Mirpur areas.

About 20,000 skilled and non-skilled workers are engaged in producing these attractive traditional sarees. Handloom Board sources said.

In the exhibition there are different types of sarees named as the Katan, Sharteen, Brokat, Baluchari, Jamehahar, Monchuri, Kanchivaram, Figure, Resham Buti and Jamadani.
