The Jahangirnagar University (JU) authorities condemned yesterday the reported assault on the JU football players on the Dhaka University (DU) playground on Wednesday.

In a statement, released by the Director of the Department of Physical Education, Khairul Islam Khan also criticised the organising committee of the inter-university football competition for declaring the DU football team winner.

The players and fans of the DU team allegedly beat up the JU football players and picked up a JU student from the ground at the 36 minutes of the first half of the match. Following the attack, Rómel and Jubayer were rushed to the DMCH with serious injury.

The kidnapped student, Bulbul — a third year student of Statistics is still missing — the statement added.

The statement further said that the DU organising committee played a mysterious role during the incident.

Rotary Int'l Past President due today

He was the President of Rotary International in 1978-79.

Three important projects have been carried out under this programme in Bangladesh. These are fisheries development project in Comilla, livestock development project in Mymensingh and MOSTI (Manually Operated Shallow Tubewell for Irrigation) project in Dhaka at a cost of over 1 million US dollar.

A large number of farmers in these places have been benefitted through these projects.

Rtn Clem Renouf will visit Comilla, Mymensingh to gain experience of different projects with a view to exploring the possibility of replicating these projects in other parts of the world.

In addition, he will also address the Rotarians in an in-tercity meeting tomorrow at Sonargaon Hotel.

Tk 1.12 cr spent for uplift of Buddhist temples

The Buddhist Religious Welfare Trust has spent Tk 1.12,15,000 so far for repair, reconstruction and maintenance of Buddhist temple, bihar, pagodas and kiang in different areas of the country since its inception in 1984 with a capital of taka one crore only, reports UNB.

This was stated at the 24th parliamentary standing committee meeting on the Ministry of Religious Affairs held Thursday at the Sangsad Bhaban with Religious Affairs Minister Muhammad Keramat Ali in the chair.

Other members of the committee attended the meeting were Khandaker Badr-uddin, Moulana Ataur Rahman Khan and Begum Asia Rahman of BNP and Alhaj Moulana Obaidul Haque of Islami Oikkya Jote. Additional Secretary in-charge of the Ministry of Religious Affairs Anwarul Islam was present.

The meeting was told that Taka 14 lakh has been allocated for the translation work of the Tripiitak in Bengali for the Buddhist people of the country during the fiscal 1994-95.

The Tripiitak is written in Pali language in 29 original books with 51 volumes. So far, 23 original books have been translated in Bengali and the translation work of the rest of the original books will soon be completed.

It was further informed that steps have been taken to establish five Buddhist religious libraries in Dhaka, Chittagong, Rangamati, Khagrachhari and Bandarban districts and four more libraries in Cox's Bazar, Patuakhali, Comilla and Barguna districts will also be established soon.

Dr Sirajul Haq's death condoled

Speaker Sheikh Razzak Ali, Deputy Leader of the Jatiya Sangsad Professor A Q M Badruddoza Chowdhury, Deputy Speaker Humayun Khan Pannu, Energy and Mineral Resources Minister Dr Khandaker Mo-sharraf Hossain, Housing and Public Works Minister Bar-rister M Rafiqul Islam Mia, Education Minister Jamir-uddin Sircar and Minister for Fisheries and Livestock Abdullah al-Noman yesterday expressed deep shock at the tragic death of Dr Sirajul Haq MP (Sherpur-3) says BSS.

Dr Haq died at a road accident yesterday at about 11 am while he was on his way to Sherpur from Dhaka by car.
