## Terry Fox lives on

The members of the National Academy of Performing Arts and Fine Arts staged a colourful cultural show in the city yesterday to raise fund for cancer research to honour the memory of Terry Fox.

The Canadian community in Bangladesh and the Bangladesh Cancer Society jointly organised the show at the Shilpkala Academy in collaboration with the academy yesterday evening.

At a discussion before the show, chief guest State Minister for Cultural Affairs Prof Jahanara Begum recalled Terry Fox, a Canadian student who suffered from bone cancer in his right leg from 1977 and died in 1981, yet braved to run across Canada to raise funds for cancer research.

Canadian High-Commissioner Jon J Scott, who was special guest, speaking in Bangla said that the Terry Fox Run or the "marathon of hope" was organised in over 40 countries annually, and it was being organised in Bangladesh for the first time on Friday. Some one thousand school children will participate in the run in Dhaka.

Terry's marathon of hope took place in 1980 with the aim to raising awareness of all Canadians of the critical need to find a cure for cancer. Although his right leg was amputated six inches above his knee he used to run 26 miles everyday on his artificial leg for 143 days.

Before he could complete his mission, Terry died in June 1981. However, his marathon helped raise 24.17 million dollar to date over 150 million dollar has been raised worldwide to support the innovative cancer research initiatives.

The function was also addressed by president of the Bangladesh Cancer Society, Prof F S Haq as special guest and director general of the Shilpkala Academy Mobarak Hossain Khan, who presided over it.

The funds to be raised through the cultural show and the Terry Fox Run in the city will go for cancer research in Bangladesh.

Meanwhile, special arrangements at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital have also been planned, one organiser of the programme told The Daily Star last night.
