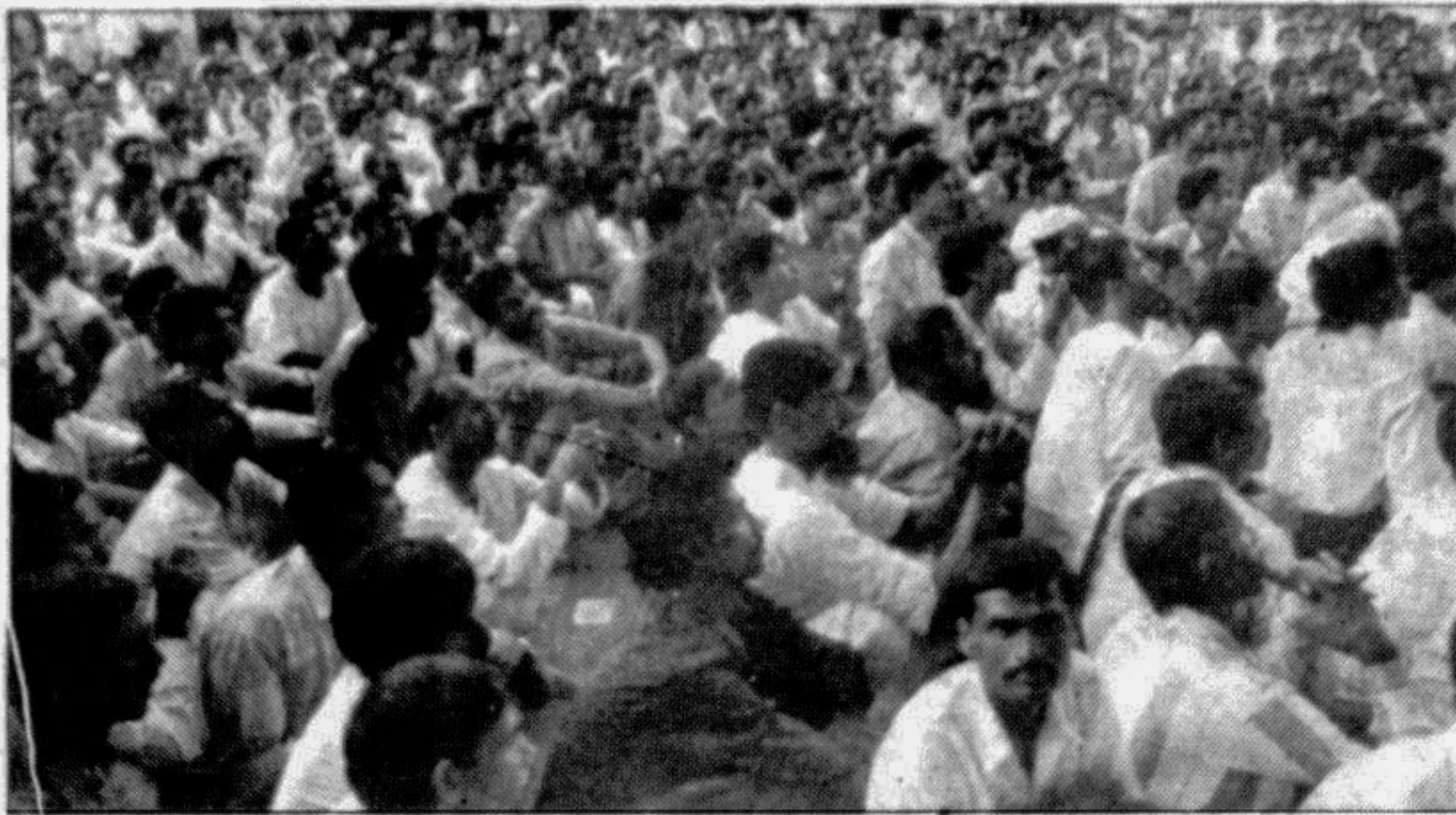

Maiden Terry Fox Run in Bangladesh today

The first ever Terry Fox Run in Bangladesh will be held today to raise funds for innovative cancer research and create cancer awareness in the country, reports BSS.

The run was first launched in 1980 by a Canadian youth, Terry Fox, who had one of his legs amputated due to cancer, to raise awareness among the Canadians of the critical need to find a cure for the deadly disease.

Over one thousand school children will take part in the run which will begin at 8 am from the Canadian Club near Gulshan Circle-1 and end there trekking a four kilometre route.

This was said at a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club, jointly addressed by the president of the Bangladesh Cancer Society, Prof S F Huq, Canadian High Commissioner Jon Scott and chairman of the Terry Fox Run organising committee in Bangladesh, Peter Nesbitt.

Scott said Terry used to run 26 miles everyday for 143 days and completed half of his mission to collect one dollar from each Canadian before he died in June 1981. To date, over 135 million Canadian dollar has been raised worldwide in his name, 84 per cent of which retained in the country of origin and 16 per cent was returned to Canada for cancer research, Scott added.

Nesbitt said this year more than 40 countries took part in



A Terry Fox Run to raise money and awareness of cancer in their respective countries.

He handed over a cheque of Tk 8,02,225 to the president of the Bangladesh Cancer Society from the first Terry Fox Run for cancer research in Bangladesh.

He said, the Terry Fox foundation, with the help of 5000 volunteers, organise a yearly fund raising event in Canada in which five lakh Canadians take part in 3000 run sites across the country in Terry's honour.

Prof S F Huq said, on the basis of international survey it was estimated that 1,50,000 die of cancer and two lakh people get fresh attack in Bangladesh every year. He said that at present the country had about eight lakh cancer patients.

He said, the cancer society would soon take initiative for establishment of a cancer hospital and research institute at its own land.
