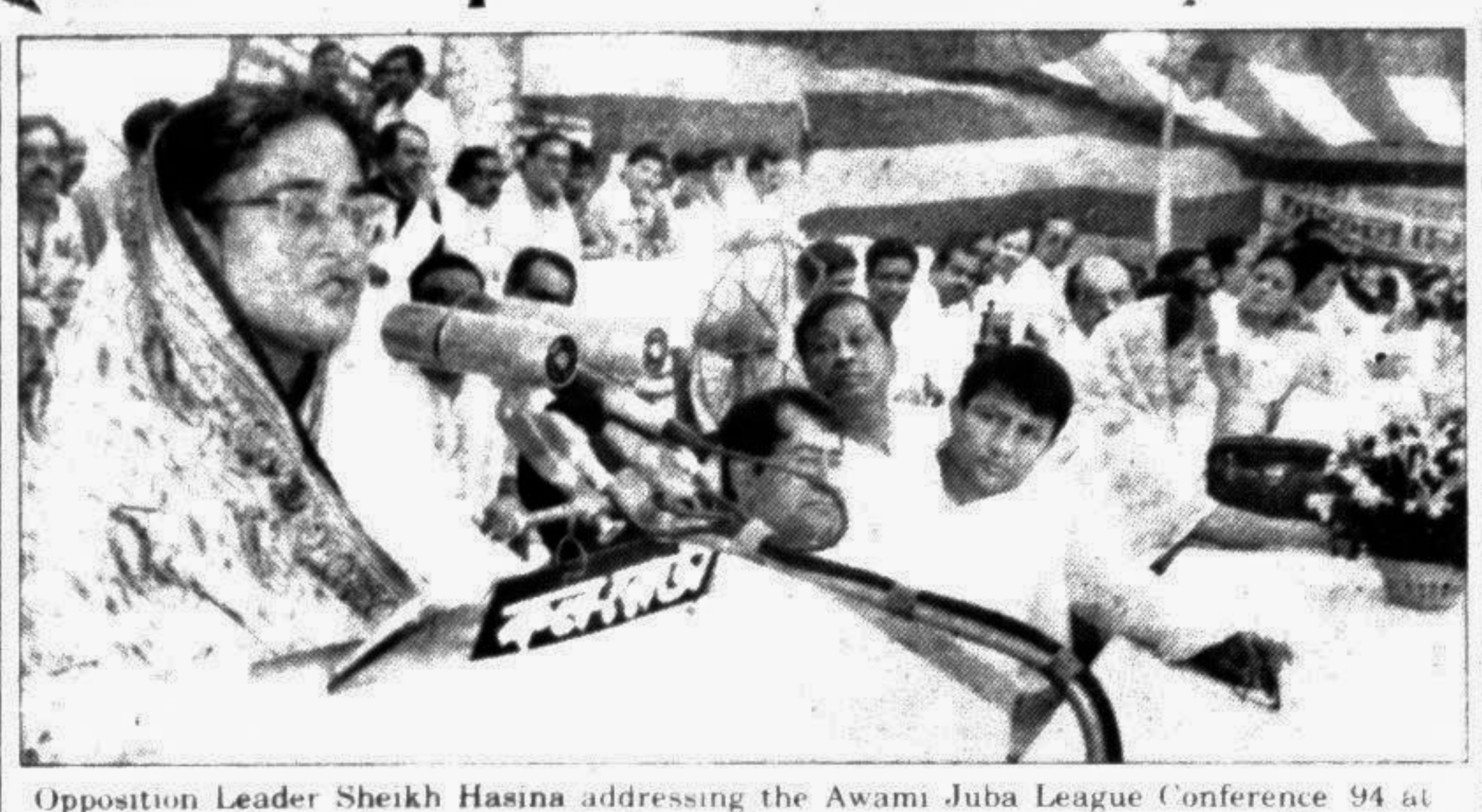

Over 60 pc transports have no fitness certificates

More than 60 per cent of public transports in the country, particularly in the capital, are without fitness certificates, reports UNB.

This was disclosed by Abdul Haque, president of the Bangladesh Reconditioned Vehicles Importers and Dealers Association (BARVIDA), at a discussion meeting on the draft Environment Law yesterday.

Quoting a survey report conducted by his organisation recently, he said those vehicles, mainly bus, minibus and trucks, do not have any legal paper, even the registration certificates.

"These vehicles can not be traced out after they commit accidents as they are without relevant papers," said Haque, the owner of the Haq's Bay, an automobile sales and display centre.

He alleged that the owners of those vehicles place their transports on roads through "underhand deals with a shadow administration that exist within the framework of legal administration."

The renowned automobiles dealers also pointed out many automobiles emit black smoke containing carbon-monoxide and white smoke containing lead because they are not fit to be operated on roads.

The present Motor Vehicles Act, formulated in 1939 and amended in 1940, under which the highest penalty for emitting black smoke is only Tk 200, he said.

Haq also informed that the new vehicles, imported from India and Japan, don't have anti-pollution device as that is not required for importing vehicles in Bangladesh.

But the reconditioned vehicles from Japan have the anti-pollution device because that country is very much conscious of environment, he said.

He suggested that the authority should formulate clear guideline for importing vehicles in the countries.

Repression on women

Directives to expedite cases

Law enforcing officials of all thanas have been directed to receive cases relating to atrocities on women and carry out quick enquiries and behave well with woman complainants an official handout said, reports BSS.

It was informed at the 3rd meeting of the inter ministerial coordination committee for resistance against repression of women and children with State Minister for Women and Children Affairs Begum Sarwari Rahman in the chair held in the city yesterday.

Recommendations were made in the meeting to fix time-limit for speedy disposal of cases in courts relating to repression of women and children, the handout said.

The Information Ministry has been requested to take measures to broadcast various programmes including magazine programmes and drama in radio and television to create awareness among the people against women atrocities.
