The Bangladesh Red Crescent Society donated Tk 12 lakh to the families of the volunteers who died on duty during the April 1991 cyclone in the coastal areas, reports UNB.


Chairman of the BRCS Syed Shahidul Huq Jamal, MP, handed over the cheques to the affected families at a simple function in the city yesterday.

The assistance is part of a Tk 43 lakh grant for these families by the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies.

Twenty-two volunteers had died while evacuating people during the disastrous cyclone and tidal bores in the Chittagong coast.

Each of these families had earlier been given two bundles of CI sheet and Tk 7,000 by the BRCS Chairman on instruction from Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia.

Speaking on the occasion, the BRCS Chairman expressed the hope that the families would be benefited by these grants while others encouraged to work during such emergency in future.

RAJSHAHI, Nov 12: State Minister for Establishment Aminul Haque yesterday said that each and every citizen had equal rights in all fields of accustomed life in the country. reports BSS.

Prokrichi BCS 'hatred day' tomorrow

Members of the Prokrichi BCS Central Action Council will observe a 'hatred day' tomorrow across the country to register their resentment against the 'colonial bureaucracy.'

They will also observe a leave en masse on the day.

The decision to express hatred and enjoy leave by the Prokrichi workers was taken at an extended emergency meeting of the council in the capital yesterday.

On the day, the Prokrichi members will also bring out a silent procession and burn effigy of the bureaucracy in front of the Jatiya Press Club.

Meanwhile, the Action Council has deferred its planned national convention of the representatives from November 14 to November 24.

A statement of the Prokrichi said that it would announce its future programmes on November 25.

At the meeting for educational and cultural evaluation of the tribal communities Haque said that in Bangladesh the Muslims, the Hindus, the Buddhists and the Christians as well as different tribes had been living in an atmosphere of harmony for centuries.

Chaired by Markush Marandi, the meeting was also addressed by among others, Azizur Rahman, MP, Shish Mohammad, district BNP joint secretary, and Shamual Marandi.

JS obituary references

The Jatiya Sangsad yesterday adopted obituary resolutions at the sad demise of Dr Mohammad Sirajul Huq, a member of the fifth Parliament.

A politician, physician and social worker, Dr Huq was killed in a road accident on October 28 last on his way to his village home from Dhaka.

The House also made obituary references on the deaths of former parliament members Principal Abul Kalam Majumder and Wali Ahmed, former provincial assembly members Sarder Sultan Mahmud and Begum Hamida Chowdhury and internationally reputed painter S M Sultan.

Deputy Leader of the House Prof A Q M Badruddoza Chowdhury, Works Minister Rafiqul Islam Mia, Posts and Telecommunications Minister Tariqul Islam, State Minister for Cultural Affairs Prof Jahana Begum, Deputy Minister for Health Sirajul Huq, Whip Abdul Karim, Moulana Ataur Rahaman Khan, Golam Mohammad Siraj, Mojibur Rahman Sarwar, M A Jinnah, Rahima Khondker, Abdul Ali and Amanullah Chowdhury spoke on the references recalling the contributions of the deceased.

Prof Badruddoza Chowdhury recalled his association with Dr Huq as his student in the medical college. Describing Dr Huq as a dedicated social worker and courageous man, Prof Chowdhury said, 'We have a lot to learn from his life.'

He paid tributes to Principal Abul Kalam Majumder as a valiant freedom fighter and also as a promoter of education. He described painter S M Sultan as a man of international fame for his unique style.

S M Sultan was a recipient of the Independence Award, which is the highest national award in recognition to his contributions to the cultural field. Dr Chowdhury mentioned.

Public Works and Housing Minister Rafiqul Islam Mia recalled the participation of Dr Sirajul Huq in the standing committee meeting of his ministry prior to his departure for his village home on the fateful day. He paid tributes to him as an able parliamentarian and social worker. He recalled the contributions of Principal Majumder who was closely associated with various social and political activities in Comilla. He described Wali Ahmed as a great politician having profound love for the people.

Death condoled

Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal ibne Yusuf yesterday expressed his profound grief at the death of eminent political leader Abdur Rahman Bakaul, reports UNB.
