## Dhaka Day by Day

### Lacklustre Tourism Mela

If BTV's rosy projection is to be believed, the place should be teeming with Bangladeshi and foreign visitors enjoying the start of tourism month. Unfortunately, as far as the Savar mela goes, the reality is a little different. Tourists are barely trickling in despite the generous TV coverage. And who can blame them? Although inaugurated with much pomp and fanfare, the mela is nothing special compared with the countless others which will dot the winter calendar. The 20 or so stalls offer what you will find everywhere else: flower pots, leather goods, ceramic gift items, and clay statues.

Take Amulla Chandra Paul and his brother Ramendra, for example. Business at their stall in the far left hand corner is rather slow, although his unpainted clay sculptures are quite attractive. This mela is the same as last year's, Amulla says, but he adds that his stall has made some improvements because they won the first prize for his mermaid statue, last year.

His main attraction this time is "the peacock boat" which took him 12 days to make. "I thought of the kings of the past travelling in beautiful boats and decided to make one in the form of a bird," Amulla explains his inspiration. He is asking Tk 2,500 for his signed piece.

But the stall hasn't sold much so far, even though the brothers proudly display a colour photo of themselves in a Bangla daily. "There are a few more people in the evening, but otherwise there haven't been that many visitors," Amulla informs pointing to the 30 or so of them milling around, including three Japanese tourists.

Yet on the opposite end of the mela, Badsha and his two helpers Nargis and Neela, seem to be doing quite well. Pockets of passersby are gathering around the stall managed by the Jahangirnagar University students.

The multicoloured vases on display are unlike the other items at the mela. The clay pieces are covered by streams of various colours resulting in a "marble effect". "I don't like the ordinary enamel paint used by the others," Badsha, a Masters student in archeology explains, "I thought it would be good to use some colours."

It took him six months to learn the colour-composite technique at an NGO called Manonite Central Committee, which exports similar items. The vases are mass produced at a factory and then painted by Badsha. "We've sold 3,000 pieces from this morning," Nargis, a charming first year student informs. The smaller items which sell like hot cakes, are only Tk 10, whereas their most striking piece, a large deep blue vase wrapped in thin red and black stripes is Tk 250.

"They're popular because the clay vases are beautiful and cheaper than ceramics," Badsha explains, "Last year we tested out a few of them and they all sold out halfway through the mela duration." They have been so successful that Badsha considers this more of a future profession than a hobby.

The demand for Badsha's vases shows that visitors are quite willing to attend melas and purchase tidbits as long as there something new on offer. Unfortunately, only one stall met this need. More efforts are required to attract foreigners, let alone locals used to these events. Outdoor food stalls, live music, children's play areas, and a greater variety of goods on display, would have made this fair worthy of tourism month. Less "wedding lights" on the Parjatan headquarters, and more sparkle at the melas, please.
