He was admitted to the DMCH.

Taka 4 crore to be spent for development of SSMCH

About Tk 4 crore will be spent for the development of the Sir Salimullah Medical College Hospital (SSMCH) during the current fiscal year, reports UNB.

The Health Minister said that the government had given priority to the health sector with a view to increasing medicare facilities of the country. He sought cooperation of all concerned to achieve the goal.

DCC decides to earmark spaces for plantation

The Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) yesterday decided to earmark spaces to plant trees as part of the afforestation project of the metropolis, according to a city corporation press release, reports BSS.

The decision was taken at a high level meeting on afforestation project at the Nagar Bhaban with Mayor Mohammad Hanif in the chair.

The meeting, after reviewing the afforestation schemes of 1993-94, asked the Dhaka divisional forest officer, the member-secretary of the project, to identify places in the city for planting more trees during the current year.

BPC to set up central control cell in Ctg

A central control cell will be set up at the BPC (Bangladesh Petroleum Corporation) headquarters in Chittagong to maintain steady supply of fuel oil in the country's northern region, reports UNB.

A meeting of the parliamentary standing committee on the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources was held yesterday that the government had planned an elaborate programme to ensure normal supply of fuel oil in the northern region during the dry season that generally begins from January.

Besides the central control cell, the programme includes setting up of a northern control cell at Bogra and commissioning of three floating barges with 500 metric ton capacity each at Nagarbari ferry ghat and railroad and mobile depots at Rangpur, Santahar and Natore.

Energy and Mineral Resources Minister Dr Khandker Mosharraf Hossain chaired the 18th meeting at Sangsad Bhaban.

The meeting was informed that due to BPC's massive precautionary measures there was no crisis anywhere in the country during the last three years. It appreciated BPC's efforts in keeping supply of fuel oil normal and steady all over the country.

The country's demand for fuel oil is increasing at the rate of 10.13 per cent. The demand of petroleum products will rise to 22.32 lakh metric tons this fiscal year against 19.54 lakh tons last year (1993-94).

Only 2 per cent of the total demand comes from the domestic productions while the rest 98 per cent from import. The country spends Taka 1,219.57 crore in FY 1993-94 for importing petroleum products.

Speakers at a discussion yesterday maintained that political crisis is the main barrier to the country's industrialisation, reports UNB.

Employment scope will not be created without industrialisation and industrialisation is not possible without political stability, they opined at the discussion on "Industrialisation of Bangladesh and Unemployment Problem".

National Democratic Party Chairman Anwar Zahid addressed the discussion as chief guest. It was organised by National Workers Federation chaired by its President Alamgir Majumdar at the auditorium of Jatiya Press Club.

Six-point demands of DU science faculty students

Later, the students body submitted memoranda to the Deans of the Science and Biological Science faculties.
