VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

The Department of Narcotics Control, Ministry of Home and the United Nations International Drug Control Programme (UNDCP) are seeking the following National Consultants for the two sectoral projects under the Master Plan for Drug Abuse Control in Bangladesh:

1. National Policy/Planning Consultant :
Working with a team of national and international staff representing both Government and the NGO sector, under the guidance of the project Coordinator, the consultant will assist in the development of a national drug abuse prevention strategy. The strategy will address two main challenges: treatment and rehabilitation of drug-dependent people and prevention and public education for non-users and potential users.

The Consultant will be responsible for:

- Provision of logistic support to the Department of Narcotics Control demand reduction plan ning activities
- Organization of methodology for community feedback on draft demand reduction policy
- Organization of and participation in community workshops
- Compilation and reporting of results of workshop
- Collaboration with international expert for the preparation of a final strategic planning document
- Assistance with orientation of field staff to demand reduction activities

Organization and delivery of community workshops for review of the draft demand reduction policy will constitute the major portion of this work. This position will be recruited under a service contract arrangement with UNDP/OPS for a period of four months. Salary will be in the range of Tk. 42,000 to Tk. 55,000 per month.

Qualifications will include a Graduate Degree in Social Sciences with at least ten years of practical experience in community development. The successful candidate will have excellent interpersonal skills as well as a sound capacity to manage public forums.

2. National Visualization in Programme Planning (VIPP) Facilitator :

Working with a team of national and international staff and the Government of Bangladesh, under the guidance of the Project Coordinator, the Consultant will assist the Women Affairs Directorate to develop a curriculum to train women in drug abuse prevention. The Master Plan targets women as key players in two sectors: as drug abusers and as family leaders and educators whose role in community mobilization is vital to drug abuse prevention.

The Consultant will be required to:

- In collaboration with UNDCP, strengthen the concept of VIPP within Women Affairs Department
- Conduct VIPP for the planning of preventive drug education under the jurisdiction of Women Affairs Department
- Reports results to UNDCP and DNC

The position will be recruited under a short term service arrangement with UNDP/OPS for a period of 1 month. Salary will be in the range of Tk. 50,000 to Tk. 60,000 per month.

Qualifications will include an established credential in the practice of VIPP with a proven track record of success.

3. National Community Development Consultant

Working with a team of national and international staff representing both Government and the NGO sector, under the guidance of the project Coordinator, the consultant will assist in the development of a national drug abuse prevention strategy. The strategy will address two main challenges: treatment and rehabilitation of drug-dependent people and prevention and public education for non-users and potential users.

The Consultant's duties will be:

- to participate in the design and delivery of community forums to review a draft policy for drug demand reduction
- to organize forums
- to collect and report results
- to assist with orientation of field staff

This position will be recruited under a service contract arrangement with UNDP/OPS for a period of 3 months. Salary range will be Tk. 50,000 to Tk. 60,000 per month.
