Re-Tender Notice for Sale of Pakistani Uncurrent Coins

Sealed quotations are invited from the interested firms/organisations intending to purchase 7 (seven) kinds of uncurrent metallic coins, such as, (1) Half rupee and quarter rupee of nickel, weight 64.58 metric tons (2) 50 paise and 25 paise of nickel, weight 91.00 metric tons (3) 10 paise of copper and nickel, weight 6.00 metric tons (4) 5 paise of copper, zinc and nickel, weight 3.00 metric tons (5) 1 paise and 2 paise of aluminium, weight 2.00 metric tons (6) 1 paise and 2 paise of copper and zinc, weight 3.40 metric tons (7) One rupee of nickel, weight 45 Kg. on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The intending buyers will have the option to collect sample of all types of coins (5 of each denomination) against payment of Tk 50/- for each of the full set from the Accounts Department-1, Bangladesh Bank, Head Office, 5th Floor, Dhaka. Intending foreign buyers may procure sample coins as mentioned above through their Local Agents/Embassies/High Commissions in Dhaka on payment of US \$ 2 for each of the full set. Sample coins will not be supplied through mail.
2. Price: Price is to be quoted in US Dollar per metric ton and shall remain valid for 120 days from the date of opening of the tender. The coins under sale would be made available by the Bank at its Chittagong & Khulna Offices in case of foreign buyers.
3. Earnest Money: Earnest money (refundable) against each quotation at the rate of 2% of the total quoted price must be submitted separately for each kind of coins in the form of Bank Draft/Pay Order drawn in Bangladesh Taka. In case of foreign bidders, the Bank Draft/Pay Order is to be drawn in foreign currency in equivalent US Dollar. The Bank Draft/Pay Order should be payable to Bangladesh Bank (Accounts Department-1), Head Office, Dhaka and submitted along with the tender. Tenders without earnest money will not be considered. Earnest money will be forfeited if the selected bidders fail to lift coins within a scheduled time.
4. Terms of Payment: Local buyers will pay the total value of coins in Bangladesh Taka before lifting coins by Pay Order/Bank Draft in favour of Bangladesh Bank (Accounts Department-1), Head Office, Dhaka. For foreign buyers, payment is to be made by an irrevocable and confirmed documentary letter of credit established in US Dollar in favour of Bangladesh Bank (Accounts Department-1), Head Office, Dhaka. Bangladesh payable documents for actual weight of coins to be delivered.
5. Terms of Delivery: Coins will be delivered to local buyers from Bangladesh Bank, Motijheel, Dhaka, Chittagong, Khulna & Sylhet duly weighed and packed in gunny bags. Delivery will be made to foreign buyers at Bangladesh Bank, Chittagong & Khulna. The coins will be packed in gunny bags duly weighed.
6. Submission of Tenders: No tender document/prescribed form will be required for participation in the bid. Bidders may submit tender in their letter head pad with full particulars. Tenders must reach the General Manager, Accounts Department-1, Bangladesh Bank, Head Office, Dhaka, Bangladesh before 11:00 am on 02.01.1995. Tenders will be opened at 11.30 am on the same day in presence of bidders or their authorised agents, if any. Conditional or incomplete tenders and tenders submitted after the closing time, will not be considered.

DUTA demands suspension of 2 teachers

The Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) Tuesday demanded suspension of two Professors of Economics of the university against whom departmental colleagues have raised some serious allegations.

The DUTA also demanded immediate investigation and necessary action against the two.

The association in a meeting with the teachers of the Economics department Sunday, also expressed solidarity with the demands of the academic committee of the Department.

The teachers of Economics department Monday demanded dismissal of two fellow teachers for their alleged corruption and unethical practices.

The allegations against those teachers include selling of question papers and giving extra grades in return for money.

Meanwhile, the DUTA Tuesday expressed concern over the allegations.

The executive committee of the association also urged the Vice Chancellor to take necessary measures to uphold the prestige of the teachers of the Economics department.

Alleged anomaly in Comilla Board SSC result '94

The results of the SSC examinations for the year 1994 announced by the Comilla Secondary Education Board have brought to light some irregularities, upsetting results of students expecting places in the merit list, reports UNB.

An example of such anomaly has been traced in the result of one BM Rashedul Islam Rasel, bearing roll number 5.83.505. A meritorious student of the Al-Amin Academy, Chandpur, he expected a place in the merit list.

Rasel said his hopes were shattered because he was given 49 marks in the General Mathematics paper, although he was fairly sanguine about scoring over 90 in that paper. On an average he secured over 78 per cent marks in all the other papers.

Having failed to reconcile himself with the poor marks in the General Mathematics, Rasel filed a petition, as per rules, with the Comilla Board for re-examination of his General Mathematics script.

Over two months have lapsed since the filing of that petition, but no reply has yet come to the candidate. The rule provides that the Board must re-examine the script within 15 days of the receipt of a petition.

Convinced of the justness of the candidate's complaint, the Education Minister, Jamiruddin Sircar, telephonically instructed the Chairman of Comilla Board to look into the matter immediately and to make sure that the candidate is not denied justice.

But the Chairman of the Board has not yet cared to reply to the minister, nor has he made necessary arrangement to re-examine the paper and send reply to the candidate who has been suffering great mental agony.

The Board is learnt to be delaying dispatch of a reply to the candidate because it is said to be trying to cover up its incompetence and corrupt practices likely to be revealed in the event of re-examination of the examination script.

HC rule on Mukhtijoddha Sangsad groups

The High Court Tuesday issued rule on both factions of the Mukhtijoddha Sangsad to maintain the status quo regarding elections till January 4, 1995, reports UNB.

A division bench of the High Court comprising Justice Mozammel Hoque and Justice Nurul Islam issued the rule following a Civil Revision sought by the advisers of the sangsad against the 'so-called' conference preparatory committee, says a press release.

The advisers of the Mukhtijoddha Sangsad include Justice Kamaluddin Hossain, Justice KM Subhan, Kalim Sharafi and Dr Zillur Rahman Siddique.

The plaintiffs instituted the suit against the conference preparatory committee comprising Brigadier (Retd) AJM Aminul Hoque, Major (Retd) Syed Munirur Rahman and Mahubul Alam with the Court of Subordinate Judge, 1st Court, Dhaka.

They prayed that the alleged meeting, held at the Biswas Sahitya Kendra on June 5 this year in the name and using the monogram of the Mukhtijoddha Sangsad, which formed the preparatory committee, be declared illegal.

DUTA concerned at killing of BUET teacher

The Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) yesterday expressed shock and concern at the killing of Engineering University teacher Prof Azmal Hayat Ahmad, reports UNB.

In a statement, DUTA president Prof M Shahadat Ali and General Secretary Dr AAMS Arefin Siddique demanded immediate arrest and trial of the killers.

They said the teachers' community as well as the nation had lost a sincere teacher and 1st class urban planner at the death of Azmal.

They also conveyed sympathy to the bereaved family members.

BPC's talking bird show concludes

A three-day long bird and aquarium fish exhibition organised by the Bangladesh Parjatan Corporation (BPC) at its head office complex in the city concluded Tuesday, reports BSS.

The exhibition was organised in observance of the ongoing Tourism Month '94.

CHITTAGONG, Dec 7: Detectives of Chittagong Metropolitan Police arrested 27 gamblers from a club in Doublemooring area here last night, police said today, reports BSS.

Police also recovered take five thousand and some gambling equipment from the gamblers.

Cases have been filed with Doublemooring police in this connection.

Hotels, restaurants given 30 days to take licence

The government Tuesday gave residential hotels and restaurants 30 days to register and take licence or face legal action, reports UNB.

Bangladesh Hotel and Restaurant Ordinance 1982 has made registration and licence compulsory for residential hotels having 10 rooms and above and restaurants with 30 seats and above.

The law, which took effect from July 1991, provides fine upto Tk 5,000 for non-compliance and in addition, Tk 1000 as fine per day of default in paying the fine.

A government notification Tuesday asked the hotels and restaurants to apply to the Controller, Bangladesh Hotel and Restaurant Cell, Civil Aviation and Tourism Ministry, for registration and licence within 30 days.

Prior to that, the applicants require to pay registration and licence fees through treasury chalan in the Bangladesh Bank. The original copy of the chalan has to be attached with the application.

The authorities have started listing the hotels and restaurants not yet having registration and licence.

"This is the last request to the hotel and restaurant owners", warned the notification issuing the one-month ultimatum.

Islamic confce begins in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Dec 7: A three-day international Islamic conference began at Patiya Jameya Islami groud here today under the auspices of the Jameya Islami, a Jameya press release said, reports BSS.
