With the UN's mission nearly paralysed the situation has intensified calls for a complete withdrawal of peacekeepers from Bosnia, NATO nations on Wednesday ordered their military experts to speed up planning for a withdrawal. NATO's supreme allied Bangladeshi peacekeepers in the Bihac region — the northwestern pocket where some of the most severe fighting is raging was the most tangible evidence of the UN's inability to protect and supply its own forces, much less civilians who are running out of food.

WASHINGTON, Dec 8: The United States is prepared to deploy ground troops if UN peacekeepers are evacuated from Bosnia, a Defence Department official said today. In Brussels, a diplomat said the United States informed its European and Canadian allies within the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation of the decision, without specifying how many soldiers might be involved in such an operation, reports AFP.

commander in Europe, US General George Joulwan, confirmed today that the Atlantic alliance was drawing up contingency plans for a possible UN withdrawal from Bosnia.

Extra ground troops would be needed to cover the withdrawal, French Foreign Minister Alain Juppe said Wednesday. Sending more troops raises the possibility of further entanglement in the morass. The decision to withdraw about 400 of the 1,200




