

kets to be open if you're not open. There's no free ride any

. The Islamic Development Bank (IDB), which helps the OIC's many poor member countries, needed to focus less on public works projects and be more business-oriented. she said.

The bank, operating on Islamic principles that prohibit charging interest, should try to help start export businesses by providing loans for leasing property such as ships or textile plants.

traded fell to 68 from 80, in which 23 gained, 38 incurred losses and the share prices of seven issues remained unchanged.


