# Reliving the Glory through National Flag

Each year around this time a common sight in the streets of the city is that of some men carrying poles that are adorned with different sizes of the national colours. Chan Miah is one such flag vendor making rounds of the city streets from dawn to dusk for at least four days in a row. Hailing from Faridpur, he is not your runof-the-mill landless farmer seeking his fortune in the big city. Rather he has enough land to sustain a family of five members and comes to Dhaka to earn some extra money in the offsea-

The selling of the symbol of national independence for him is a temporary break with his usual occupation as a fruit-vendor in the Gulistan area. With his special merchandise, he starts his rounds around eight in the morning from the Gulistan area and goes on until dusk. Asked about his sale, he modestly replies that the first days are always better than the rest. This year he sold flags worth Tk 1,200 on his first day out.

How it feels when walking all day with no particular destination? He smiles and says that it's worth the effort. He also adds that contrary to popular beliefs, his wares are in great demand and that his customers vary from teenagers to old folks. He is only a cog in the machine of the

making of the flag itself. His employer has a workshop where he manufactures the flags and then distributes the lot among men as Chan Miah who walk around the town and sell them. Whatever Chan Miah can get over and above the rate is his to keep. In all, the workers make the flag in eight different sizes and prices range from Tk 5 to Tk 50. He relates how an officer from an office nearby came and bought the largest one ·Chan Miah had to offer. "You should have see his excitement as he took delivery of his piece of the symbol of liberty." Chan Miah smiled knowingly as if to prove that people still remember and they still care. Each day on an average Chan Miah sells flags worth Tk 600 to 700 - sometimes more - and he is happy with what he can

How is the job different from others? "The inner satisfaction is greater in this case," comes a casual reply. He adds that by doing this each year, maybe, he is reliving the glorious past of his beloved country. After all it is the symbol of the much-coveted freedom that his children enjoy today. Maybe, it's his way of repaying those who put down their lives so that people like him could live. Maybe, it's something that just cannot be put into words. It's something you have to
