



# Dhaka Day by Day

## In a Rate Race

A group of people elbow each other, their faces contorted with effort as they push and shove, vying for the front line. Some swear under their breath while others gasp for air. Are they boarding a launch in Sadarghat or grabbing a seat on the bus? You might think so if it were not for a large wreath. They are our politicians from all sides, farcically striving for a brief moment of glory on national TV, while laying wreaths for the shaheed (martyred) intellectuals.

Two days later, our leaders once again risk creasing their suits, sarees and kurtas to place wreaths on the Victory Day. The same cattle market scene could be true for other political gatherings. People will go to great lengths to be photographed with the Prime Minister or the opposition leader? "Look, I am the leader's close associate." Anyone behaving in a civilised manner is sure to get trampled. Impatience, short cuts and queue jumping are the way to

Waiting patiently for your turn is not just an alien concept with politicians, but also for the city at large. Hum and haw for a minute and your chance is gone. There are hundreds of

others waiting to take the short cut. Take an example as "basic" as washing your hands after a wedding. As a model citizen you quietly await your turn while the woman in front simultaneously lathers her hands and engages in an hour-long conversation. Just when you think the sink is yours, a stocky woman barges her way through, grabs the soap and carries on as if nothing has happened and you stand there bewildered. Following her example, others jostle in impatiently. Will the sink disappear and the world end if they don't wash their hands then and there?

Or try the hairdressers which can be safely called the most competitive place on earth. It doesn't matter that you arrived first. You need to dash for the nearest chair as soon as the occupant budges even slightly. Or line up for gasoline where two puny baby taxts are bound to squeeze past your car. Or go to the post office, where a mass of bodies swarm around the counters. They don't even pretend to line

Perfectly decent, educated, and even intelligent people bare their teeth and claws as soon as they see a queue. People could be lining up for cheap rubbish, but that doesn't matter. Everyone will be busy devising 101 short cuts. All that counts is getting there first. Try to get a free cup of tea after a seminar, and you'll know what competition means. The Dhakaites live under this fear that everything exists in a finite quantity. If you don't grab the opportunity, someone else will to your detriment. These people are not the poor and starving masses, yet they still harbour a need to hoard.

Queue behaviour is only a symptom of a larger social affliction. Why line up and buy tickets if you can crash the concert venue? Why go to parliament when you can take to the streets? Why work hard if your palms can be greased? And why wait if everyone else is getting ahead? Officials itching for promotion, for example, will do anything to get ahead: bootlicking, gift buying, edging out other competitors by spreading rumours.

Joining the line is useless with so many people striving for the same goal in the same rat race. But that's not much of a consolation when you're waiting at the post office.




