

# 'Memory of Jagadish Bose should be preserved'

Sir Jagadish Chandra Bose was not only a celebrated son of the soil, he was a scientist of world acclaim and his works should be preserved.

This was the observation of the speakers at a discussion on Sir J C Bose on the occasion of the inauguration of 'J C Bose Memorial Conservatory' at Rarikhal in Munshiganj district while observing the 136th birth anniversary of the late scientist yesterday at Sir J C Bose Institute situated at his village home, reports BSS.

Begum Sufia Kamal said the memory of Sir J C Bose should be preserved through the conservation of his works. 'I met him at the residence of Rabinranath Tagore when I was in my teens,' she said.

'I came to Munshiganj and visited the residence of the scientist 24 years ago. I found the plight of his residence, but happily those days are gone. The condition of the school Post Begum Sufia Kamal was the chief guest at the discussion while Dibakar Sen, superintendent of Bose Institute and Museum in Calcutta, attended it as a special guest. The function was chaired by Mahmud ul Haq, president of Sir Jagadish Chandra Bose Foundation

which organised the programme. After his name has been improved,' she added.

Begum Sufia Kamal stressed the need for preserving the memory of the great scientist.

Dibakar Sen cited the illustrations of the works of Sir J C Bose. He said 'microwave' was invented by Bose two years before Marchese Guglielmo Marconi had invented radio.

Sen presented a bunch of works of Sir J C Bose to the foundation for the conservatory.

The discussion was participated by Syed Mosaddek Hossain Jahangir, secretary of the J C Bose Foundation, Aminur Rahman Khan, advocate Mosharruf Hossain, Md Helal Uddin, Abdul Khaleque, headmaster of Sir J C Bose Institution, Mir Mozammel Ali, Abul Kashem Khan, Mir Moksed Ali and Qayyum Khan Milon.

Later the bust of Sir J C Bose was unveiled by Begum Sufia Kamal and the conservatory by Dibakar Sen. Thousands of people visited the conservatory where samples of works of the scientist have been placed.

## One killed, two hurt in road mishap

A young woman was killed and two others were injured when a speeding truck hit their rickshaw on Bogra-Nagarbari road at Sreekola in Ullapara thana, Sirajganj Sunday, reports UNB.

The victim was identified as Beauty Khatun, 20, of Bakura village of Ullapara thana. Beauty who died on the spot was a hawkler by profession.

Seriously injured Halima, 20, who hailed from the same village and rickshawpuller Razzaque, were admitted at the Ullapara health complex.

The Nagarbari-bound truck tumbled into a roadside ditch after hitting the rickshaw running toward Ullapara.

Police seized the truck. The driver, however, fled away.

A case has been filed with the local thana.

## Baby poisoned to death

A new born baby was poisoned to death allegedly by her father in a village in Sadar thana yesterday, reports UNB.

The 11-day old baby daughter born to Farida Banu, the 4th wife of Chand Master of Kalaniya village, was found dead this morning at her grandparents house, police said.

Farida Banu alleged that her baby was poisoned by Chand Miah, her husband — as he did not want the child in the first place. She said Chand Miah persuaded her give up the child on the pretext that their marriage took place without the consent of his third wife.

Farida filed a case with local police against Chand Miah.

**BHRC urges Opposition to postpone scheduled resignation**

## Looted clothes seized in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Dec 26: Detectives of Chittagong Metropolitan Police (CMP) in a raid seized different kinds of looted clothes worth about Taka half a crore from a house at Zakir Hossain Road under Panchlaish thana here last night, reports BSS.

# Shajahan Siraj joins BNP

Referring to the demand of the three main opposition parties for a caretaker government to conduct future elections, Siraj criticised them for not placing this proposal in Parliament.

He categorically stated that there is no scope for such a government within the constitutional framework of Bangladesh and other countries where parliamentary democracy is functioning.

Siraj said the agitation for a caretaker government does not reflect what the common people, particularly farmers and workers, want.

The threatened resignation of the opposition MPs is also contrary to the people's hopes and aspirations and would hamper the democratic process, he added.

Siraj, a freedom fighter who read out the declaration of independence as the General Secretary of the Chhatra League in 1971, castigated the Awami League for joining hands with the anti-liberation forces responsible for the killing of 30 lakh people during the Liberation War, and the autocratic forces of 1980.

'It will destroy the democratic institutions on the one hand and cripple the economy on the other,' he said, adding that the people had not given anyone the right to resort to 'political barbarism' by calling frequent hartals.

By calling frequent hartals, Siraj said, several political parties are pushing the country to uncertainty and discouraging foreign investment.

Turning to the allegations of vote fraud, he said it was the Awami League which committed massive rigging in the elections of 1970 and 1973.

The Awami League, as the ruling party, snatched his victory and that of late Major Jai, a prominent freedom fighter, in the 1973 elections, he added.

Recalling the contribution of late president Ziaur Rahman to the Liberation War, he said it was Zia who gave the call for liberating the country from Pakistani forces.

He, however, mentioned that the contribution of Sheikh Mujibur Rahman to the liberation of the country could never be ignored.

Siraj in his speech listed development successes of the BNP government in different sectors including education, women's development and rural uplift.

Addressing the function, Deputy Leader of the House Prof A Q M Badruddo Chowdhury described Siraj as a 'courageous soldier in the Liberation War and democratic struggle'. He said Siraj had always responded to the historical necessity of the nation and played his due role.

BNP Secretary General Abdus Salam Talukdar also addressed the function, congratulating Shahjahan Siraj and his followers who joined BNP.

Tangail district BNP president Hamidul Huq Milon, former MP Mazharul Huq Chowdhury, Gano Forum leader Nazrul Islam Khan and Begum Rabeya Siraj also spoke on the occasion.

Agriculture Minister M Majid-ul Huq, Telecommunications Minister Tariqueul Islam and Religious Affairs Minister M Keramat Ali were present.

Earlier, Ziaul Huq Zia, a ruling party MP, presented a golden replica of a sheaf of paddy, the election symbol of the BNP, to Shahjahan Siraj.

## BNP govt introduces dev-oriented politics'

RAJSHAH, Dec 26: Minister of State for Land Kabir Hossain has said that the BNP government had introduced development oriented politics and for this reason different pragmatic steps to change the lot of common masses was being successfully implemented throughout the country, reports BSS.

He was addressing a public meeting held yesterday at Bhatkhali High School premises of Bugmara thana under the district.

The state minister said, the government is keen to turn Bangladesh into a country of people's welfare by eradicating illiteracy, eliminating poverty and creating employments. He, however, noted that some vested quarters were hindering the uplift activities for their selfish outlook and trying their best to oust the democratic government from power before fulfilling its five-year term.

Kabir urged the people irrespective of party affiliation to foil all kinds of conspiracies by engaging themselves in nation building activities.

The public meeting was addressed, among others, by general secretary of district BNP Advocate Kamrul Munir, district organising secretary Saleh Uddin Baby, city organising secretary Advocate Ershad Ali Esha, president of district Chhatra Dal Nadim Mustafa and professor of Taherpur College Ferdous Khan, presided over by Jugipara union chairman Abdul Latif.
