All children under five will be immunised against polio in a nationwide campaign backed by Rotary International, a rotary leader said yesterday, reports UNB. Mahbub elected Rotary Governor: The Rotarians of Bangladesh elected an International executive, Mohammad Ali Mahbub, as their district governor for the year 1996-97 on the last day of their district conference on Saturday, says a press release. Mahbub, 58, defeated Dr Fazlul Karim of the Rotary Club of Chittagong, by an overwhelming margin in the election where 86 clubs with a total of 91 votes cast their ballot. His prime task will be to inject new dynamism in the Rotary movement in Bangladesh, said Mahbub in his post election briefing. He said, he would strive to spread the Rotary across the country in various fields of social-welfare activities. Dr Fazlul Karim, also a senior Rotarian from Chittagong, conceded defeat soon after the results were announced, by past district governor Azizul Haq. Mahbub a director of ICDDR, B, has been a Rotarian since 1972. He is currently a member of the Rotary Club of Dhaka Buriganga and has played an active role in the club's aim of changing the lot of the 12,000 people of Angorpotia-Dahagram enclave. He also contributed significantly to setting up of the Rotary Cancer Detection Unit in Dhaka, read the release.

Biswas urges police to ensure people's security

President Abdur Rahman Biswas yesterday called upon the senior police officials to dedicate themselves in ensuring safety to the citizens of the country, reports UNB. "You are to prove yourself as the real friend of the people," he said. "Life and property of the citizens should be protected at any cost to keep the image of the police high," he told a team of police officers, who called on him at Bangabhaban yesterday morning. Recalling police heritage of the country President Biswas said, people in general wanted a peaceful social life which is a prerequisite to national development. Police had a better scope in moulding public opinion in favour of family planning, mass literacy and development-oriented programmes of the government, the President said. He advised them to build up a man to man relationship in their locality and to dispose cases quickly without any fear or favour. He said, "Law is to be followed in letter and spirit" and people's reaction should also be assessed for future course of action. Responsibilities of the police officers had increased to a great extent in the present democratic set-up, Biswas said. And stressed combating the anti-social elements firmly keeping in mind that police are the servants of the republic.
