### 'Govt policy aims at creating equal opportunity for all'

CHITTAGONG, Jan 8: Prime Minister Beguin Khaleda Zia today said her government's policy aimed at creating equal opportunity for all in government jobs giving priority on merit and eligibility, reports

"It is not possible to build an honest and enterprising administration without talent and competence," she said addressing the inaugural function of the 39th national convention of the Institute of Engineers. Bangladesh (IEB) in the port city this evening.

Mentioning the unemploy ment problem. Begum Zia said the joblessness of country's higher-educated and skilled manpower is 'very painful to all of us.

You (engineers) must agree that it is not possible for us to ensure government job for all the new engineers. Keeping it

in mind we have been creating self-employment opportu tittles for fresh and skilled professionals," she told the engineers.

The Prime Minister sought specific proposals from the Engineers Institution in this respect and assured them of insidering their proposals with due importance.

The objective of 22 years of struggle was to build a democratic polity in the country and also to achieve economic emancipation.

She said after restoration of democracy, her government education programmes, and has also undertaken measures to achieve economic growth and poverty alleviation.

The Prime Minister stressed the need for innovation and application of modern technology, increasing production and attracting enhanced foreign capital for stepping up economic growing. She also underlined the need for infrastructural development in this regard.

Now we are on the threshold of new century. The twenty first century will be dominated paramountly by science and technology," she said calling for preparing the nation to face the challenge.

Deputy Leader of Parliament Prof. A Q M Badruddoza Chowdhury inaugurated the two-week long exhibition \*The exhibition will remain



Ziauddin, 55, who has been serving Chittagong Develop ment Authority (CDA) as its Chairman since September 1993 married Jahanara at his official residence in Chittagong on December 30 at a simple function Jahanara is now in her mid-30s.

Ziauddin joined Liberation War and was Commanding Officer of Dhaka garrison in 1972 He had to leave the army alter writing a politi cal article in an English weekly of Dhaka

Soon after, he involved himself in the activities of the Sarbahara Party of Straj Sikdar and became a prominent leader of that underground or ganisation.

Ziauddin remained actively associated with the party until 1988 when he left it due to difference of opinion with others. He has been leading a normal life in open since then and was appointed Chairman of the CDA afterwards.

The country, particularly the northern region, may experience another spell of cold wave right after the next one or two rainy days, they added.
