The four municipal elections will be held at Chandpur, Sylhet, Barisal and Shibirganj on January 22. "We are prepared to place a non-partisan monitor in each and every polling centre in all the four municipalities where elections are being held," said Feroz M. Hassan, SRG's Convener.

"We are confident that our presence on election day will not only help to deter and detect fraud, but will also help build voters' confidence in the election process." The SRG started a training seminar on Friday for non-partisan monitors in all the four municipalities.

Higher population: a bar to fight diarrhoeal diseases

A leading epidemiologist has cautioned that Bangladesh will hardly be able to make any significant dent in its high incidence of diarrhoeal diseases in near future if the population growth rate persists at the current high level, reports UNB.

Dr A K Siddiqui, Head of the Epidemiology of the ICDDR,B (International Centre for Diarrhoeal Diseases and Research, Bangladesh) told a press briefing yesterday that high density of population was a major factor frustrating programmes of containing incidence of cholera.

The cholera germs require a host to survive and high population density helps them, he said. The luncheon briefing was arranged on the eve of a two-day annual scientific conference of the Dhaka-based Centre that begins today.

With about three per cent growth in population, Bangladesh has the highest population density in the world. Cleaner environment, including safe drinking water and sanitation, was very important in containing highly contagious diseases like cholera, said Dr Siddiqui.

High population growth is largely barring efforts to ensure a safe environment here, he added.
