**Discussion on Zia's birth anniversary**

Secretary General of BNP and LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Abul Salam Talukdar yesterday described President Ziaur Rahman as successful statesman, far-sighted politician, proclaimer of independence and a valiant freedom fighter, reports BSS.

Addressing a function organised by the city unit of Chhatra Dal at the National Museum on the occasion of the 59th anniversary of birth of President Ziaur Rahman, the minister said President Zia was a great man in all spheres of his life.

The LGRD Minister urged the student leaders and workers to implement Zia's production and development-oriented programmes which was based on Bangladeshi nationalism.

Salam Talukdar said that when the BNP government was leading the nation towards development and progress an interested quarter was hatching a conspiracy to foil country's sovereignty and the development and progress.

He urged the students to make collective resistance against such kind of conspiracies.

**Internal revenue mobilisation rises by 23 pc**

The Industries Minister, A M Zahiruddin Khan, said that the fiscal reform programmes of the government had started giving positive results, reports BSS.

Speaking as the chief guest at the annual general meeting of the BCS (Taxation) Association at city's Officers' Club Friday, the Industries Minister said that internal revenue mobilisation increased by about 23 per cent in 1993-94 fiscal compared to that of 1991-92.

In 1993-94 internal revenue mobilisation stood at Tk 8995.61 crore while in 1991-92 it was Tk 7347.72 crore.

The minister described it as a "good sign" for Bangladesh economy that the ratio of internal resource mobilisation in relation to gross domestic product was gradually increasing.

The Industries Minister said that in 1993-94 fiscal internal resource mobilisation increased to 11.4 per cent of the GDP from 9.8 per cent in 1991-92.

The minister urged the members of the taxation service to put in their best efforts to maximise revenue earnings and contribute to building a healthy national economy.

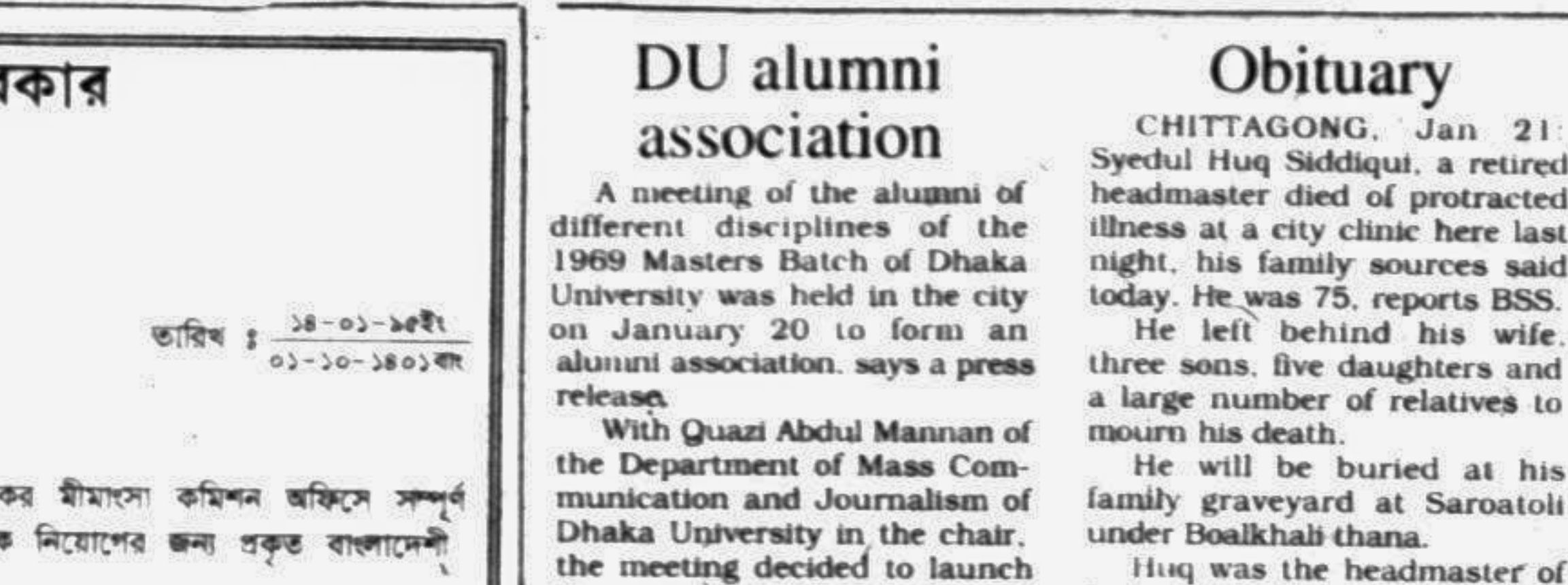

**B Chy for more satellite centres to fight rising heart diseases**

Deputy Leader of Parliament Prof A Q M Badruddoza Chowdhury stressed the need for establishing more satellite centres for combating the rising cases of cardiovascular diseases, reports UNB.

Addressing as chief guest the inaugural session of a six-day National Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases yesterday morning, he emphasised more training of doctors for treating heart diseases.

B Chowdhury, also a renowned physician, told the workshop that a coronary bypass surgery is possible here for only Tk 50,000 which is nominal compared to the expenses involved in the neighbouring country.

Health and Family Welfare Secretary Syed Ahmed and Resident Representative of World Health Organisation (WHO) Murtuza Chowdhury were also present at the session. Prof S R Khan and M Akhtaruzzaman, director of the institute, also spoke.

The Health Ministry and the WHO have jointly organised the workshop.

Resident Representative of the WHO, emphasising improvement in medicare facilities, said cardiovascular diseases were on a tremendous rise in the region.
