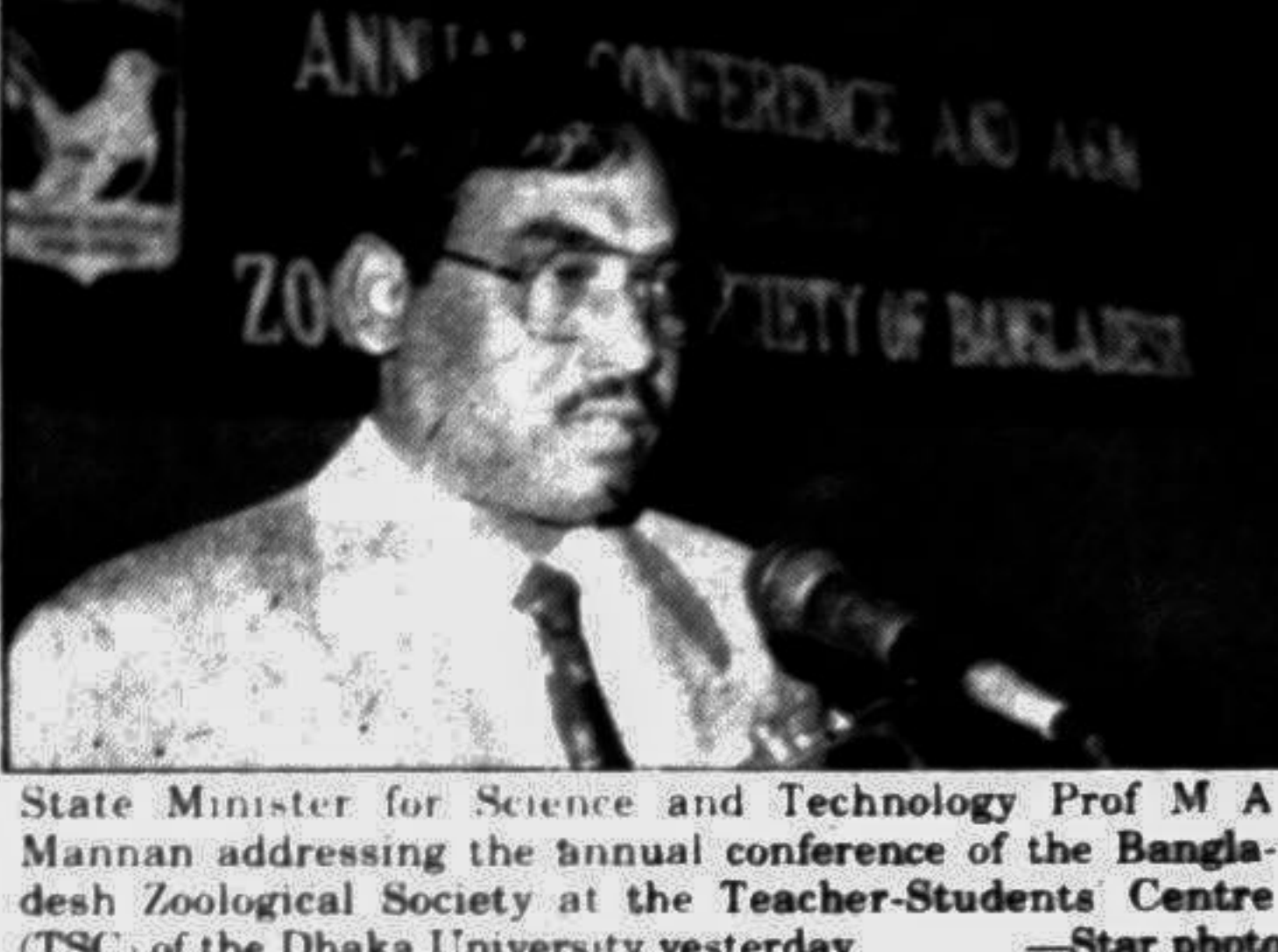

- a. The tribal candidates must submit certificates of tribal descent duly signed by the respective Deputy Commissioner;
b. Age: Applicants for undergraduate study should not exceed 25 years of age on 1 January 1996; and applicants for postgraduate study should not exceed 30 years of age on 1 January 1996;
c. Minimum Qualification:
(i) Undergraduate:
Tribal: No third division in SSC and HSC results (or O/A level (equivalent) for tribal candidates.
General: Two first division in SSC and HSC results (or O/A level (equivalent) for general candidates.
(ii) Postgraduate:
Tribal: No third class in SSC/HSC/undergraduate/postgraduate result (or equivalent). Minimum four years undergraduate or combined undergraduate/postgraduate, course(s) passed for tribal candidates.
General (including College Teachers) Minimum two first classes and no third class in SSC/HSC/undergraduate/postgraduate results (or equivalent). Minimum four years undergraduate or combined undergraduate/postgraduate course(s) passed for non tribal candidates.
5. Candidates fulfilling the above conditions may apply in English on plain paper (two sets) along with Bio-data, passport size photograph, copies of all certificates and mark sheets (duly attested). Bio-data must contain (a) Name (b) Father's Name (c) Present Address and Phone Number (d) Permanent Address and Phone Number (e) Certified Educational Qualifications including: (i) Name of Examination (ii) Board/University (iii) Year of Passing (iv) Division/Class (v) Total Marks with percentage.
Candidates may only select one (1) field of study. The proposed subject of study should be clearly indicated in capital letters on the top of the Bio-data.
