'Links with GATT, NAFTA may end control on import of medicine'

Bangladesh's connection with the GATT and the NAFTA might end the existing control on import of medicines in the country. Parliament was told yesterday, reports UNB.

Replying to Nizamuddin Khan of BNP, State Minister for Establishment Aminul Huq on behalf of the Health Minister said such connections might have an impact on Bangladesh's pharmaceutical industry.

The minister said the accords are expected to establish free import system replacing the current control on import of medicines.

Due to this, import of medicines may increase and an open competitive environment may prevail in the domestic market, he added

in reply to a supplementary from Shabidullah Khan, the minister said the government will not allow import of any substandard or harmful

medicine in the country. To another supplementary. Aminul Huq said, it will be too early to say whether these agreement will cause any harm to the local pharmaceutical in-

dustries. He, however, said the signatories to the GATT and the NAFTA agreement have definitely considered the interests of their respective countries.

Replying to Mohammad Golam Rabbani, the minister said that a plan was under consideration of the government to set up a medical university in the country.
