98 pc mosquitoes in Dhaka without malarial germs
Allaying fears that mosquitoes would cause widespread malaria and filaria in Dhaka city, a City Corporation official yesterday said 98 per cent of the city's mosquitoes belong to the culex genus, reports UNB.
Ward commissioner Kamal Chowdhury, overall in-charge of the DCC anti-mosquito crash drive, said only the female mosquitoes of Anopheles genus cause malaria and filaria. But, they are rare in the capital.
Quoting a recent survey conducted by an expert group working in the field, he called "baseless" the recent reports that the city mosquitoes would cause malaria and filaria.
In the wake of increasing mosquito menace, the Corporation has taken up a three-phase programme, the completion of which will eradicate almost 70 per cent of the mosquitoes in the city, Chowdhury assured.
The first phase of the crash programme, that include identifying and cleaning of derelict ponds and drains, releasing of 'guppy fish' in them in 90 wards of the city, has already been completed.
The second phase of the DCC drive which began Saturday to destroy 90 per cent of the breeding grounds will also include fogging, releasing fish and larvicides from spray machines.

Garments workers threaten agitation if Eid bonus not paid by Feb 26

National Garments Workers Federation yesterday cautioned the owners that they will go for protest, demonstration and blockade if the Eid bonus is not disbursed by February 26, reports UNB.
Addressing a press conference at the Tophkhana office of the federation, its general secretary Amirul Haq Amin said the workers would be compelled to go for agitation if they were not given Eid bonus which is "a legal right of the workers".
He demand payment of salary and allowances for the current month, also by February 26.
About their movement for 8-point demand, including implementation of minimum wage at Tk 950 announced by the government, Amin said the garments sector was the most exploited among the industrial sectors.
He said the minimum wage scale is yet to be implemented for the garment workers after one year of its announcement.
The garment workers, the most deprived among the industrial sector, are also denied proper overtime and other facilities, the federation general secretary claimed.
He said they would submit memorandum to the garment owners on February 7-9 and bring out torch procession in the capital on February 10 to press their demand for Eid bonus.

'Bangladesh's War of Independence' now on sale

Bangladesh's War of Independence, a book based on the BBC Bengali Service series of the same name by Atiqul Samad, has now been published and is on sale at the Ekushey Boi Mela, says a BBC press release.
The 94-page book includes transcripts of interviews with people who took part in the independence movement, journalists who reported the events and eyewitness accounts. Among them are people whose voices have never been heard before, and a speech by slain President Ziaur Rahman which has not been heard since March 27, 1971.
Interviews include the former Chief of Bangladesh Air Force, Air Vice Marshal Khondakar, who represented the Bangladesh government at the ceremony where the Pakistani armed forces surrendered, journalist K G Mustafa, columnist Abdul Gaffar Choudhury, and Ataus Samad, the former BBC correspondent in Dhaka.
DG of BDR presents souvenir to President
The Director General of Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) Major General Anwar Hossain yesterday presented some souvenir to President Abdur Rahman Biswas, reports UNB.
The souvenir includes BDR bicentennial medal, commemorative stamps and a replica of newly-built BDR Gate.

3,500 likely to perform Hajj under govt management

About 3,500 pilgrims from Bangladesh under government management are expected to perform this year's Hajj scheduled for May 8, reports UNB.
Only those who have deposited Tk 83,885 each to the specified banks before January 31 will be entitled to performing Hajj under government arrangement.
They will be exempted from health certificate and pilgrim pass fees, prices of *Ahkamul Hajj* books, costs of luggage sticker and wrist belts, according to government notification.
The money at the same rate was taken from those who performed Hajj under government management last year. Last year, some 6,000 people performed Hajj under government management.
Hajj camp, being set up at Rajuk commercial complex at Sector 6 in Uttara, is expected to be opened in last week of March.
Hajj flight is likely to begin in the first week of April.
Five ministries concerned have been working together to provide all possible facilities to Bangladeshi Hajjis in the hold land.
People from Bangladesh, outside government arrangement, will be allowed to perform Hajj on their own initiative, according to government's Hajj policy 1995.

Repair, dev of temples, maths Hindu Welfare Trust spends Tk 3 cr since '93

The Hindu Religious Welfare Trust has spent about Tk three crore in repairing, reconstruction and development of Hindu temples, maths and ashrams throughout the country since its inception in 1983, reports BSS.
This was stated at the 27th parliamentary standing committee meeting held yesterday at Sangsad Bhaban with Minister for Religious Affairs Muhammad Keramat Ali in the chair.
Members of the committee attended the meeting were Khandaker Badar Uddin, Moulana Ataur Rahman and Begum Asia Rahman, Secretary, Ministry of Religious Affairs Anwarul Islam was also present in the meeting.
The meeting was informed that there are about 20,000 temples, maths and ashrams in the country and each year about 1000 such Hindu religious institutions are being given financial help from the fund of Hindu Religious Welfare Trust.
