

Book Fair Ought to be Different

Similar look does not prevent the book fair to be different in spirit.

The Aamar Ekushey Grantha Mela '95 has started in the city at the usual venue, Bangla Academy. These are mixed feelings regarding this annual month-long fair among the city dwellers. Some wait with eager anticipation for the mela to start, while others voice their trepidations that due to mismanagement, the book fair often provides the hoodlums an opportunity to indulge in rowdiness and vandal-

In any case, this year's bot-mela too is likely to present the same typical scene: innumerable people roaming about in the open space or the dusty and congested walkways between the rows of book stalls at the academy premises. Hundreds of stalls, clustered together, dealing in the almost identical collection of books. The relentless litanies of the salespeople mingled with the poetry recitations and full-volume Hindi music creates a 'not-too-pretty' picture of the popular boi mela-cum-carnival. But, the authorities assure that this year's fair will be far more organised than the 'chaotic confusion' of the previous ones. How? A visit to the Bangla Academy provided some of the interesting facets of the ongoing mela.

ism and other unsavoury activities.

It was quite exciting to see the place getting ready for the big event. Two days before the fair the site looked practically bare, the preparations had just started. Push-carts carrying bamboo poles, cardboards and others apparatus blocked the entrance of the academy. The organisers only provide the basic bamboo structure and the course khaki material covering, the rest is up to the stall renters' imagination. The atmosphere was almost electric as there was a race against time.

Workers rushed to and fro, busily going on with their work. Carpenters were engaged in making wooden racks, commercial artists worked on the signboards, while publishing house representatives supervised the decor of the makeshift stalls. With so many stalls selling the same old books, the objective is to make them as attractive as possible to catch the buyers' bored eyes. One or two impressive looking stalls invariably draw crowds every year. Paint cans and strips of multicoloured

A barefoot painter was sqautting on the floor of one of the office buildings. deeply engrossed in writing the programme guide on some plywoods. The shaded blue, yellow and red planks with their meat black let ters are a new edition to the boi-mela, blithely confides painter with paint smeared hands. About eight painters were hired to do the art work of the academy inside, which includes painting the images of the martyred intellectuals. The public relations officer (PRO) of the academy showed a roster brought out by them, displaying the strong guidelines followed by about 46 signatures of student leaders. The codes of conduct include among others a ban on foreign music and yes, that does not exclude Hindi songs, though they have become so familiar in our country, that maybe, they won't fall into the 'foreign' category. The regulations also prohibit the selling of vulgar posters of Bollywood stars. unauthorised Indian books etc. He further informs that to prevent unfortunate accidents. like last year's fire incident or perhaps missing books, there is a firm instruction for the sales staff to be present at their individual stalls and

As the mela coincides with the holy Ramadan, the academy decided not to hold the usual cultural programmes associated with the Ekushey Commemoration, rather stick to discussions, lectures and poetry recitations.

It's too soon to tell whether the Ekushey Boi-Mela '95 will be a success or not, but the joint effort of the organisers, participants as well as the visitors can surely make a whole lot of difference.
