Sale proceeds of French auction distributed

The French ambassador to Bangladesh and his wife yesterday distributed the proceeds collected from the charity auction of French luxury goods among various humanitarian and non-government organisations.

Ambassador Jean-Michel Lacombe and Myriam Lacombe handed over cheques of varying amounts in a simple ceremony at their residence to representatives of the Mother Teresa Shishu Bhaban, Central Women's University, Women's Voluntary Association (WVA), Shanti Clinic in Magura, Milon in Chittagong, Parbatya Bouddha Mission orphanage in Khagrachhari, Association Parthage, Holy Family convent in Mymensingh and CARDMA.

The auction, held on January 12, raised Tk 8 lakh and 40 thousand from the sale of luxury products donated by renowned French companies like Chanel, Cartier, Nina Ricci, Dior, Lacoste and Givenchy.

The noble auction was organised by the Lacombes with the cooperation of the French Embassy staff in Dhaka and sponsored by Rhone Poulenc, Alcatel, Banque Indosuez and Technip.

Directives to WDB officers

In compliance with a government circular, the Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) has asked all its Class One officers to have their health examined and to obtain fitness certificates every year, says a press release.

Class One officers of the Board who are working in Dhaka will have to have their health checked and to receive fitness certificates from the Institute of Chest Diseases, Mohakhali, Dhaka.

Those placed in Chittagong, Sylhet, Rajshahi, Mymensingh, Rangpur and Barisal should obtain certificates from the respective medical college hospitals.

Officials serving at district levels other than those mentioned above will have to collect their certificates from the district-level hospitals by physicians nominated by the divisional health director or the civil surgeon.

Officers working at thana levels will have to obtain fitness certificates from concerned thana health complexes.
