Organ transplantation can save 30,000 lives annually

Lives of 30 thousands people can be saved every year in the country through organ transplantation, half of them by transplanting kidneys, said speakers at a workshop yesterday, reports UNB. Nearly 15 thousand people die here every year of kidney failure and another 10 thousand of acute kidney problem, they said. So far, 60 kidneys have been transplanted here with 90 per cent success while about one lakh people are suffering from kidney problem, the experts said. One can give life to seven people by donating his organs. Prof BA Bradley, a British transplantation expert, told the concluding session of the workshop on "Organ Transplantation" at a local hotel. Prof Bradley, Director and Head of the Department of Transplantation Science of Bristol University, conducted the two-day workshop, organised by Bangladesh Renal Association, Beximco Pharmaceuticals and Sandhani of Dhaka Medical College. Deputy Leader of the House Prof AQM Badruddoza Chowdhury addressed the concluding function as chief guest. It was also addressed by secretary-general of the Renal Association Prof Harun-Ur-Rashid, Dr KMG Haque, Dr Purubi Dutta, Sandhani president Rafiqul Islam and its General Secretary Rasheedul Hasan.

Kuwaiti embassy denies allegation

The Embassy of Kuwait in Dhaka Sunday denied the allegation that a passenger was harassed by Kuwait Airways personnel and said the passenger was off-loaded as she refused to undergo routine security check at the aircraft door. In a press release, the embassy alleged that the officials of the Civil Aviation Authority of Bangladesh (CAAB) 'mis-handled' the matter and the incident was not properly reported in the press. "Indeed the role of the civil aviation personnel present at the time shows that they mis-handled everything and in a bid to cover their sloppiness, allowed the incident to blow out of proportion," the press release said. The Bangladeshi born US national, Leena Jamali, was off-loaded from a Kuwait Airways flight on Friday creating an untoward incident at the airport and delaying the flight for about 15 hours.
