Foreign investment may drop if Congress defeated

BOMBAY, Feb 13: Predictions of defeat for India's proreform Congress Party in polis in the western state of Maharashtra have forced foreign investors to put their plans on hold, businessmen and market analysts said on Sunday, reports Reuter.

Maharashtra, India's richest and must industrialised state, has been traditionally ruled by the Congress Party.

But opinion polls say a right wing Hindu alliance of the regional Shiv Sena (SS) and the nation's main opposition Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) could overthrow the government of state Chief Minister Sharad Pawar a staunch advocate of economic reform, in the second phase of voting on Sunday.

If the government changes. a lot of equations are going to change, an analyst for a foreign investments company said.

The immediate impact of a change in government will be a drop in new investments in the state he said on condition of anonymity.

Pawar told Reuters on Tuesday that foreign investors had committed or proposed a record US 30 billion dollar in the state during the last two years all this is at stake, he

Pakistan expects bumper wheat crop this year

KARACHI, Feb 13: Pakistan is expecting a bumper wheat crop this year, the government said Sunday, amid hopes that the production target of more than 17 million tonnes would be achieved, reports AFP. It will be a bumper crop by

any standard, Food Minister Yousuf Talpur told the official Associated Press of Pakistan (APP). The minister said the

country had produced 15.1 million tonnes of wheat last year when the target was fixed at 17 million tonnes."

The production fell 6.21 per cent last year due to bad weather and shortage of water,

This year promised a better yield because acreage, fertilizer use and rainfall were all increasing, the minister said.

Wheat has been grown on an estimated 8.26 million hectares covering about 37.1 per cent of the total cropped area in Pakistan. The average yield is estimated at about 1,990 kilograms per hectare.

The country has been importing wheat for the past two decades from the United States, Canada, Australia, Germany and Turkey.

The minister said the government would keep a reserve stock this year of more than one million tonnes of wheat. 48 pc Cambodians

see economy improving

PHNOM PENH, Feb 13: Almost half the Cambodians questioned in a survey released today believe economic conditions in the country are improving, reports Reuter.

The survey of 600 people carried out by Phnom Penhbased International Management and Investment Consu-Itants (IMIC) found that 48 per cent believed the Cambodian economy was on the mend.

According to the IMIC the survey was also an endorsement of the current economic policies of the country's two prime ministers.

The respondents also approved of the policies of copremiers Prince Norodom Ranariddh and Hon Sen, who see economic growth as a potent weapons against the Khmer Rouge," said the IMIC. On the down side 19 per

cent of respondents said Cambodia was worse off because economic development had brought with it clubs, bars and massage parlours which could negatively impact on social development.

Thirty per cent said they thought there had been little change to the economy although taxes had risen. According to government

figures Cambodia's economy is forecast to grow at a rate of five to seven per cent in 1995. However, inflation levels for 1994 were estimated by the national bank of Cambodia last November at between 25 and

30 per cent.
