Rain, gusty wind likely

Rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty wind is likely at one or two places over Dhaka and Rajshahi divisions and the regions of Comilla, Sylhet, Khulna and Barisal during the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, UNB reports quoting a Met-office press release.

The Met Office forecasts weather may remain mainly dry with partly cloudy sky elsewhere over the country.

Night temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country, during the period.

Meanwhile, the capital experienced the season's first light norwester last evening. Rain accompanied by temporary gusty wind at a speed of 44 km/hr swept over the city.

According to the Met Office reading, Dinalpur had 5 mm rain, Dhaka 2 mm and Mymensingh 1 mm shower during the 12 hours till 6 pm yesterday.

In its outlook for subsequent two days, the weather office forecasts thundery days are likely.

Country's lowest temperature 16.6 degrees Celsius was recorded at Teknaf and the highest 32.5 degrees at Rangamati.

The sun sets today at 5:54 pm and rises tomorrow at 6:31 am.
