# 'Secularism not a bar to religious freedom'

A paper on "Secularism in the Post-modern Age" was presented by James J Novak yesterday, at a meeting of the Asiatic Society of Bangladesh.

Novak, author of "Bangladesh: Reflection on the Water". observed that secularism can allow for religious freedom within a society, citing the US as an example. As such, it should not be excluded from the Constitution of any country on the grounds that it opposes religion.

He pointed out that when the Constitution of Bangladesh was framed it was unmistakably secular. The memories of the war and the brutalities committed in the name of religious differences influenced this writing of the Constitution. But he emphasised that the independence war was not anti-Islam: it was against the tyranny of a majority by a minority.

Novak, an American who has done research and writings on Bangladesh and a senior Fulbright scholar went on to say that though religion is

not a sufficient foundation for a state, it can participate in the politics of a secular state, provided it is a reasoned participation. If dogma and fundamentalism are permitted to rule, then religion is reduced to a political tool.

However, according to Novak, without any form of reli gion, a society is forced to embrace extreme ideologies, such as communism or fascism. which are no longer appropri ate in our post-modern age.

Among the participants' in the subsequent discussion was Professor Salauddin, who stressed that a secular state does not entail a secular society. "Secularism is not a philosophy or doctrine but simply a state policy not to have a state religion. There is no such thing as a secular society, only a secular state," he said.

The meeting was chaired by Dr Harun-or-Rashid, general secretary of the Asianic Society, and presided over by Prolessor Sirajul Islam, president of the Society.

#### BFTA demands part of Feb salary before Eid

The Bangladesh Federation of Teachers' Associations (BF-TA) has urged the authorities to pay the government portion of their salary for the month of February before Eid-ul-Fitr through special arrangement. reports UNB.




