Weather is likely to remain dry over Bangladesh with partly cloudy sky over Rajshahi division and the regions of Tangail, Mymensingh and Sylhet during the next 12 hours ending 6 pm today, reports UNB.

No appreciable change in the night temperature is expected over the country during the period, the Met Office forecasts.

Thundery weather may develop in the next two days, it further added.

Yesterday's highest temperature 28.5 degrees Celsius was recorded at Cox's Bazar and the minimum 10.0 degrees at Ishurdi.

National Science and Technology Fellowships, 1995-96

Applications in prescribed form are invited from Bangladeshi nationals for National Science and Technology (NST) Fellowships for 1995-96. The following three categories of fellowships will be offered for facilitating research work in different fields of science and technology.

(1) General Fellowship:

(a) Part-time General Fellowship (Tk. 2200/- per month):

Minimum qualifications: A candidate must be a student at post graduate levels (Research/Thesis group) in Agriculture or Environmental Science or Medicine or Engineering or General Science etc. with placement in at least second class, Division in all other previous public examinations. This may be relaxed in case of candidates having 1st class at the graduate level.

(b) Appropriate Technology Fellowship (Tk. 2200/- per month):

Minimum qualifications: A candidate for this fellowship should have been trained in any recognised vocational institute or be a holder of Diploma from any recognised technical institute or a self-trained or made technician having technical knowledge and experience in innovation and development of appropriate technology; maximum age 30.

(c) Full-time General Fellowship (Tk. 2850/- per month):

Minimum qualifications: An applicant must have M.Sc./B.Sc (Engineering)/MBBS/B.Ag or equivalent degree from any recognised university or be a student of M. Phil/Ph.D levels with placement in second class/division in all other previous public examinations. This is relaxable in case of a candidate having 1st class placement at Bachelor's or Master's level; maximum age 30.

(2) Senior Fellowship:

(a) Senior Fellowship (Tk. 4800/- per month):

Minimum qualifications: A person with the same minimum academic qualifications as those for a general fellowship and having 5 years of research experience or MS/M.Phil degree with 3 (three) years of research experience or Ph.D degree is eligible to apply; maximum age 40.

(b) Senior Fellowship (Tk 6300/- per month):

Minimum qualifications: A person with the same minimum qualifications as those for General Fellowship and having 8 years research experience or MS/M Phil degree with 6 years research experience or Ph.D degree with 5 years research experience is eligible to apply; maximum age 40.

(3) Expert Fellowship (Tk. 7800/- per month):

A candidate with the minimum qualifications as those for Senior Fellowship and having at least 10 years professional experience in any university or research organisation as a scientist or technologist either at home or abroad is eligible to apply; maximum age 45.

2. The candidates who are in regular service in government or parastatal or non-governmental organisations are not eligible for General Fellowship. In cases of senior/expert fellowships, established professionals may apply for carrying out additional research work in their respective fields with prior permission from appropriate authority. Experience and age limit may be relaxed for candidates having extra-ordinary qualifications. The candidates should be associated with any recognised university/ educational institute/research organisation in Bangladesh.

3. Fields of research under NST Fellowships Programmes: In conformity with the national requirement, preference will be given to applied research in fields of (1) physical, engineering and environmental science; (2) biological and medical sciences; (3) food and agricultural sciences; (4) science and technology planning and evaluation; and (5) innovation of appropriate technology and development of indigenous technology.

4.
