Dhaka Day by Day WASA's Challenging Job

The WASA is the sole authority in the capial responsible for meeting the water requirements of the city's 8.6 million dwellers. It also ' oversees the city's serpentine sewerage system which carries off the refuse of houses and streets. With only three steel-make water tanks situated at Fakirapul, Mohakhali and Lalmatia, each having a capacity of 10 lakh gallons of water and several tanks of concrete with capacities varying between one lakh gallons to 1.25 lakh gallons dotting the city. WASA has failed miserably to provide the city's growing population with sufficient water.

People working at the WASA are quite unhesitating to disclose the fact that at present the WASA is capable of supplying only 50 per cent of water requirements of the city. The master plan made at the time of creation of the authority was never materialised, and instead of ten towering water tanks, only three have materialised. Each large water tank is connected with two or three large pipes penetrating some 800 ft. deep into the soil for lifting underground water. According to geologists of the WASA, the underground water is gradually going down and reaching some 800 ft. beneath the soil does not always guarantee the availability of water. At present the WASA does not

have the technology to explore if water is adequately available at further depth. The proposal for extracting more water from the Buriganga ito meet the shortfall is also not acceptable. There is the apprehension of endangering nav-

WASA people, of course, are not ready to take the blame singly on their shoulders. Why? Some unscrupulous house owners and hotelwallas instal powerful motors along WASA's underground water pipes to ensure 24-hour water supply in their establishments. Such unapproved steps certainly deprive their neighbours of one of the most useful amenities of city life.

Perhaps because of this trickery we wonder why in the same locality the people of one house has plenty of water for wastage, while another is forced to keep household activities such as washing, cooking, bathing, mopping up

of floors etc. suspended. Constant low budget for the WASA is a major problem. It needs investment. People pose the question. If Karachi can have supply of drinking water from some 1500 kilometers away. why can't we have the same from the 'Meghna

The Met Office forecasts weather may remain dry with temporary cloudy sky elsewhere over the country and night temperature is likely to remain nearly unchanged throughout the country.


Yesterday's maximum temperature was recorded 31 degrees Celsius at Teknaf and the minimum 11 degrees at Srimangal.
