The Princess is expected to call on President Abdur Rahman Biswas and Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia during her visit.



Epidemic death of bees endangers apiculture

The apiculturists of Dhaka. Manikganj. Gazipur and Tangail districts are facing serious problems due to the death of bees at an alarming rate, reports UNB.

Some apiculturists said during the last week at least one crore bees died in the 200 camps of the villagers of these districts due to indiscriminate use of adulterated and cheap pesticides in the blossoming mango trees and vegetable cropfields.

Some specialists said the bees are dying epidemically due to food poisoning while collecting honey.

After experiment over the dead and infected bees the Entomology department of the Bangladesh Agricultural Research Institute could not find out the reason of massive death of bees but suspected that it might be the reaction of insecticides and not any par-

Meanwhile, the Bangladesh Small and Cottage Industries Corporation (BSCIC) and several non-government voluntary organisations have trained up 2000 young men over apiculture in the seven districts.

Different NGOs have disbursed Tk 30 lakh among the trained apiculturists and they informed the trained youths have collected 7000 kg honey worth Tk 15 lakh from 200 honeycombs of four districts.

One NGO representative expressed fear that the apiculture would be ruined if the queen-bees die massively, and added many useful insects are dving every year due to indiscriminate use of low quality in-


